CALL FOR PAPERS

Philologi is a student-run scholarly journal deeply rooted in the history of philosophy. A forum for showcasing exceptional work from undergraduate philosophy students around the world, **Philologi** offers young philosophers a rare opportunity for peer-reviewed publication. We invite students to submit papers exploring any aspect of philosophical thought from antiquity through the twentieth century.

PEER REVIEW PROCESS

All submitted works will be initially reviewed by at least three members of the Editorial Staff, who then bring the works before the full staff with a recommendation to accept for publication, accept pending revisions, or decline, with the full staff making the final decision. The review process will begin in winter, and decisions may not be finalized until late spring. All submissions will receive a summation of editorial evaluations.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Submit papers to philologi.journal@belmont.edu by 11:59pm, January 30, 2018.
- Please prepare submissions for blind review by including the author's name and academic affiliation in a separate document.
- Papers should be in 12 pt. font with one-inch margins, formatted in Turabian (Chicago style).
- Documents must be submitted Microsoft Word (.docx) format.
- There is no formal page limit, although students are politely discouraged from submitting papers over thirty pages in length.
