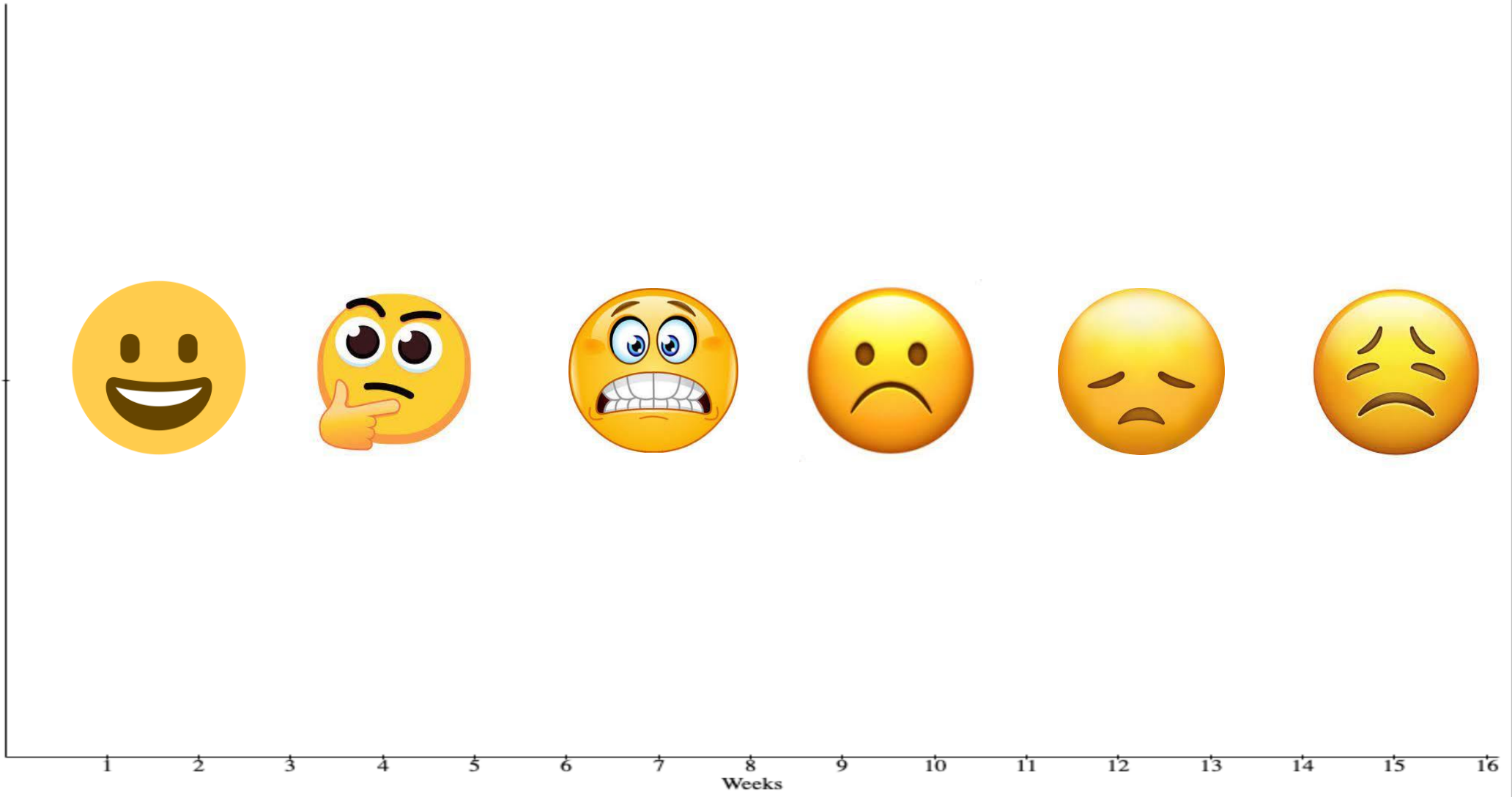
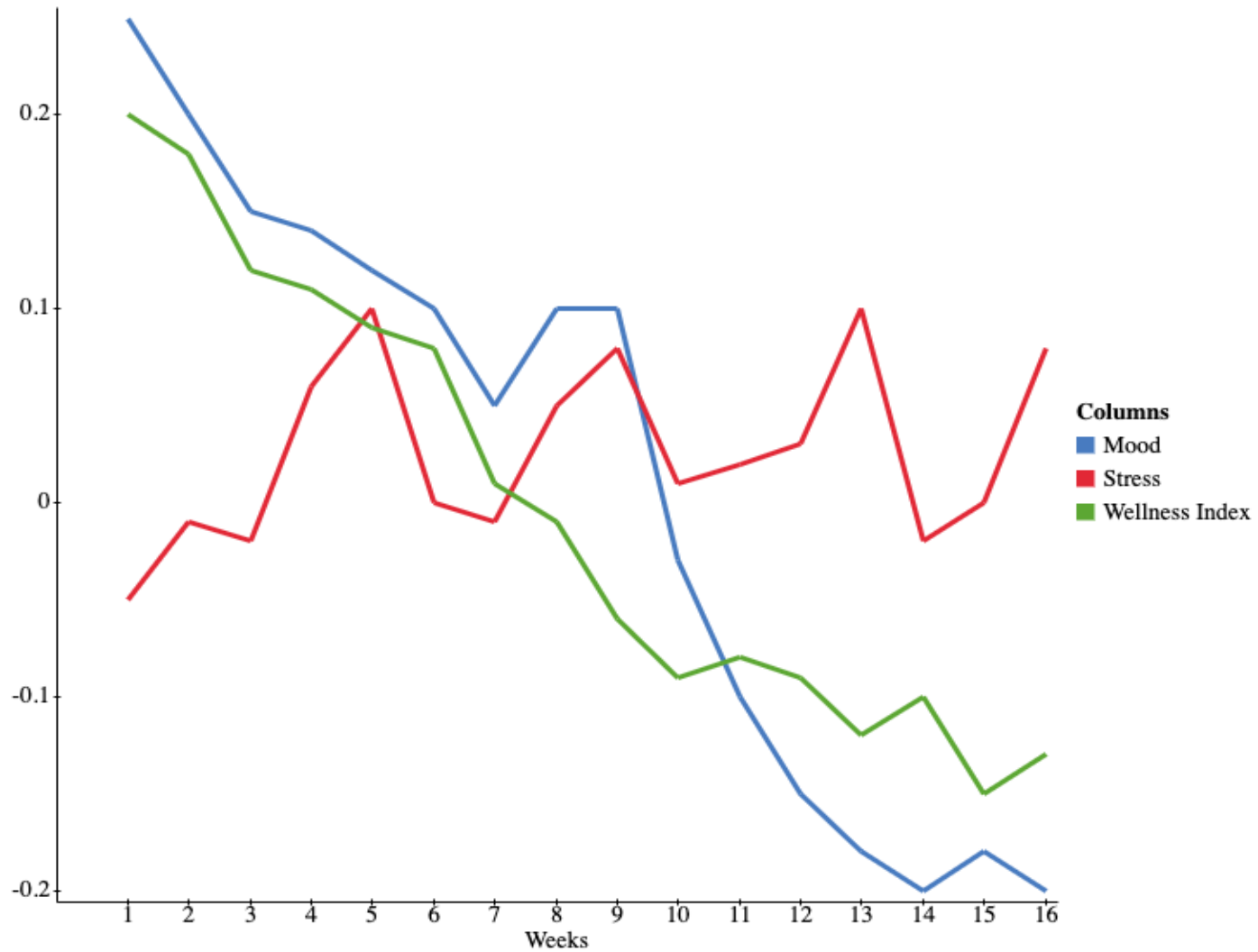

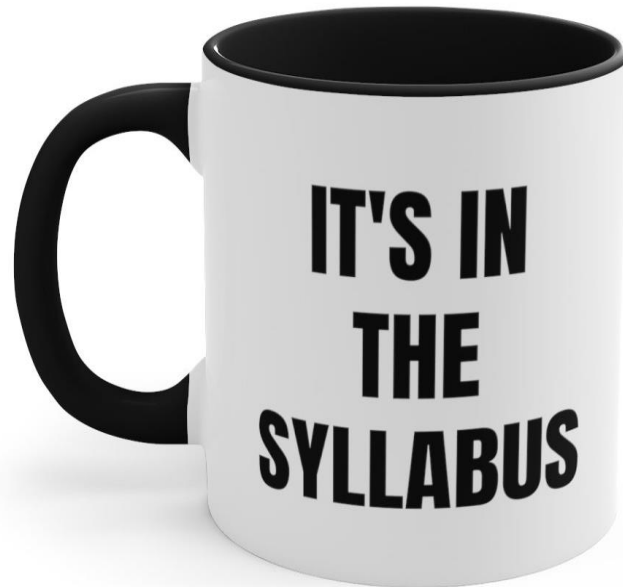


# The Syllabus
