ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

This matter was set for final hearing on April 26, 2024, before the Tennessee Historical Commission (THC). This case concerns Petitioner's request for a waiver under the Tennessee Heritage Protection Act of 2016, T.C.A. § 4-1-412, *et seq*. Pursuant to T.C.A. § 4-1-412, the THC can only grant Petitioner's requested waiver by a 2/3 vote of the entire membership of the THC. This requires a minimum of 20 Commissioners to conduct a waiver hearing. At the beginning of the hearing, the THC had 20 members present but one Commission could not attend the duration of the hearing. Accordingly, this matter was continued. The final hearing is reset for **June 21**, **2024**, **at 9:00 a.m.** Central Time in the Nashville Room, 3rd Floor, Snodgrass-Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Ave., Nashville, Tennessee 37243.
