Effective with the 2018-19 edition of the fact book, all prior summer start freshmen were added to the first-time freshmen cohort.

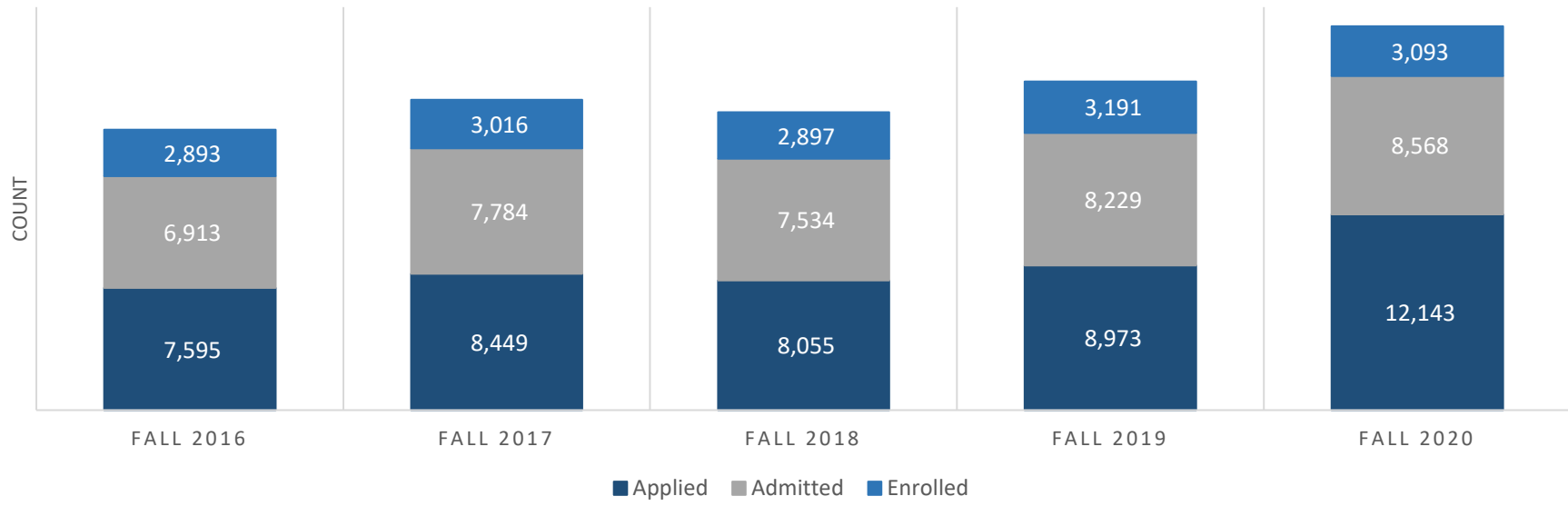

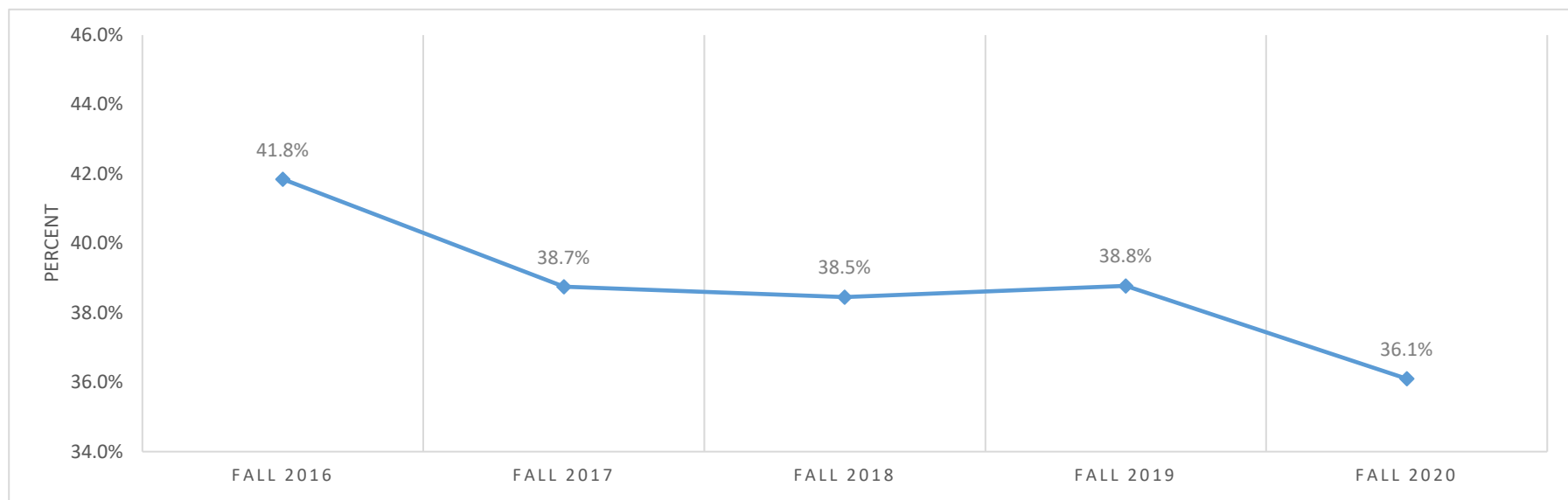

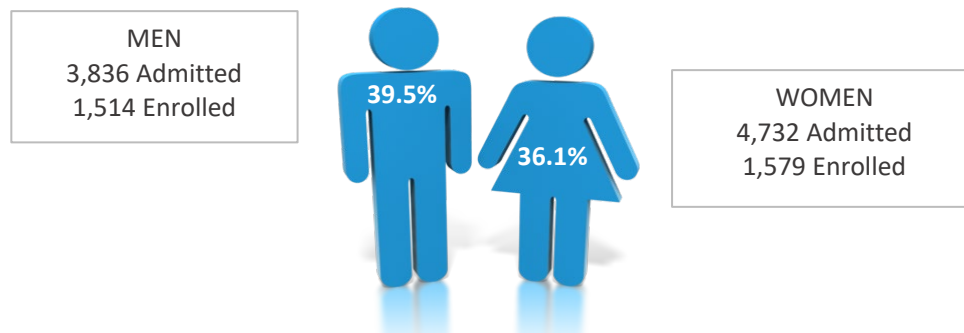
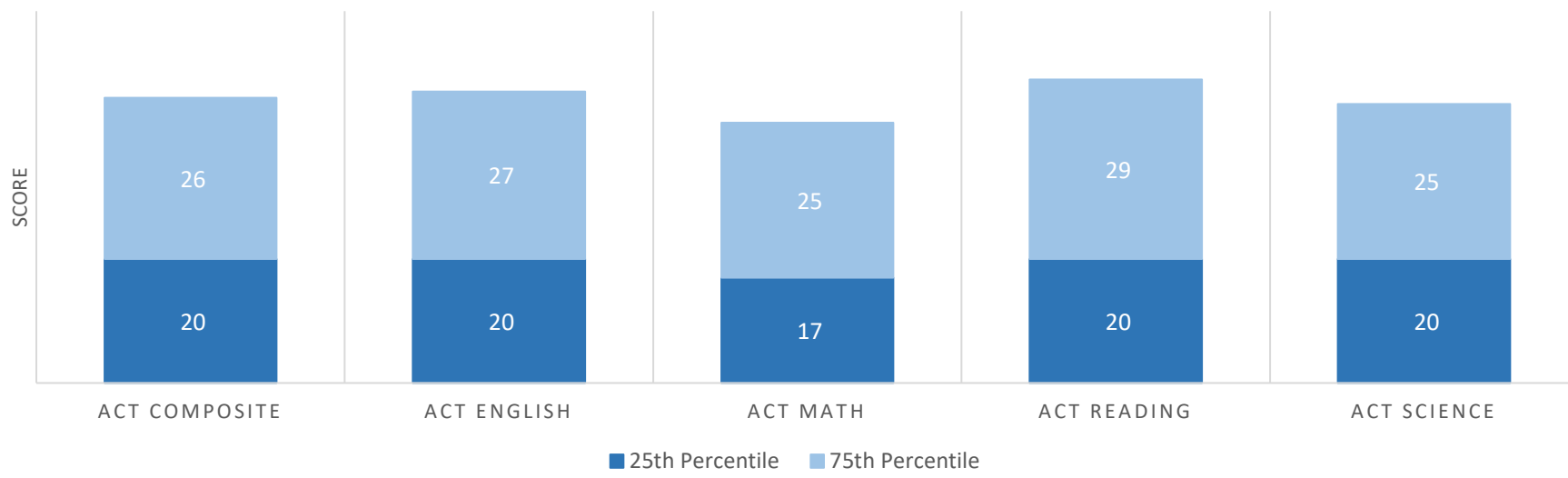
New Freshmen Applied, Admitted and Enrolled

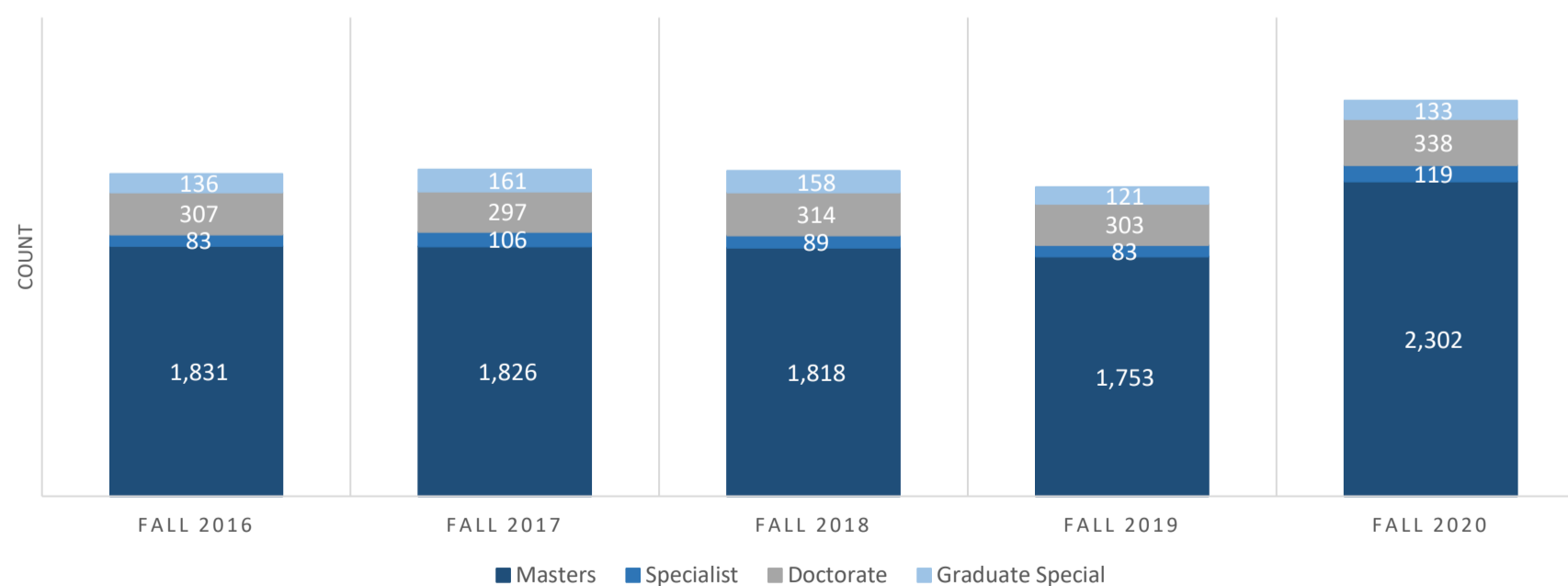

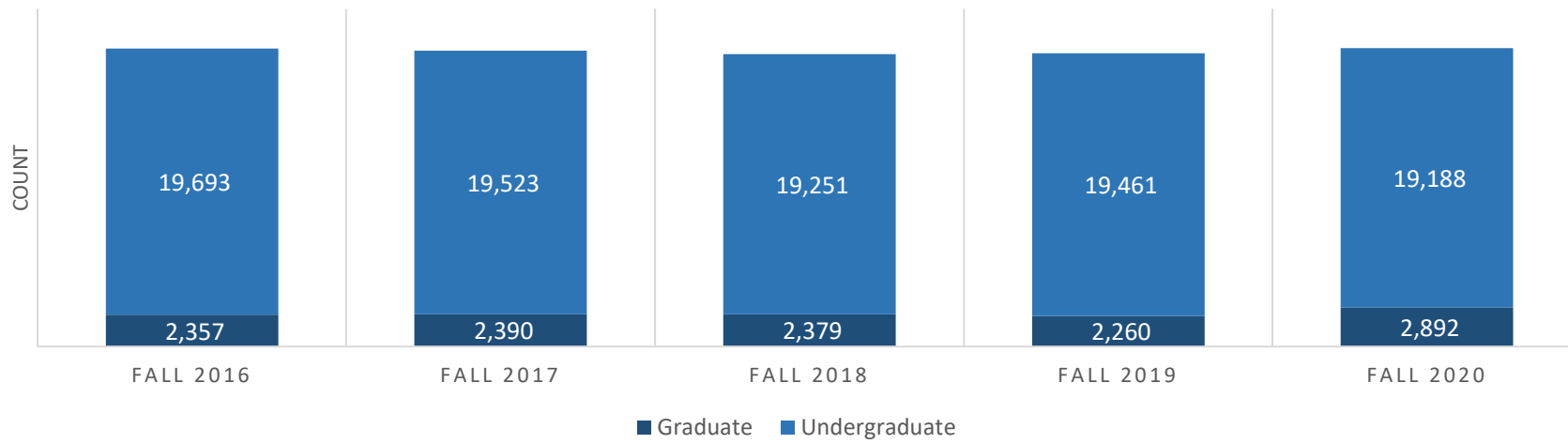

Graduate Headcount by Classification

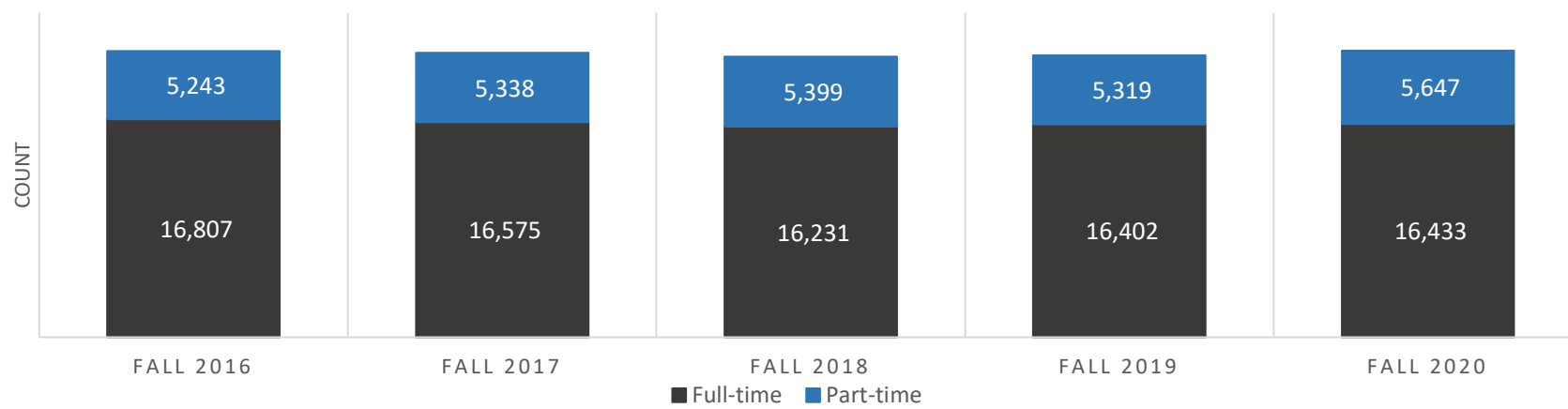

Total Fall Headcount by Enrollment Status



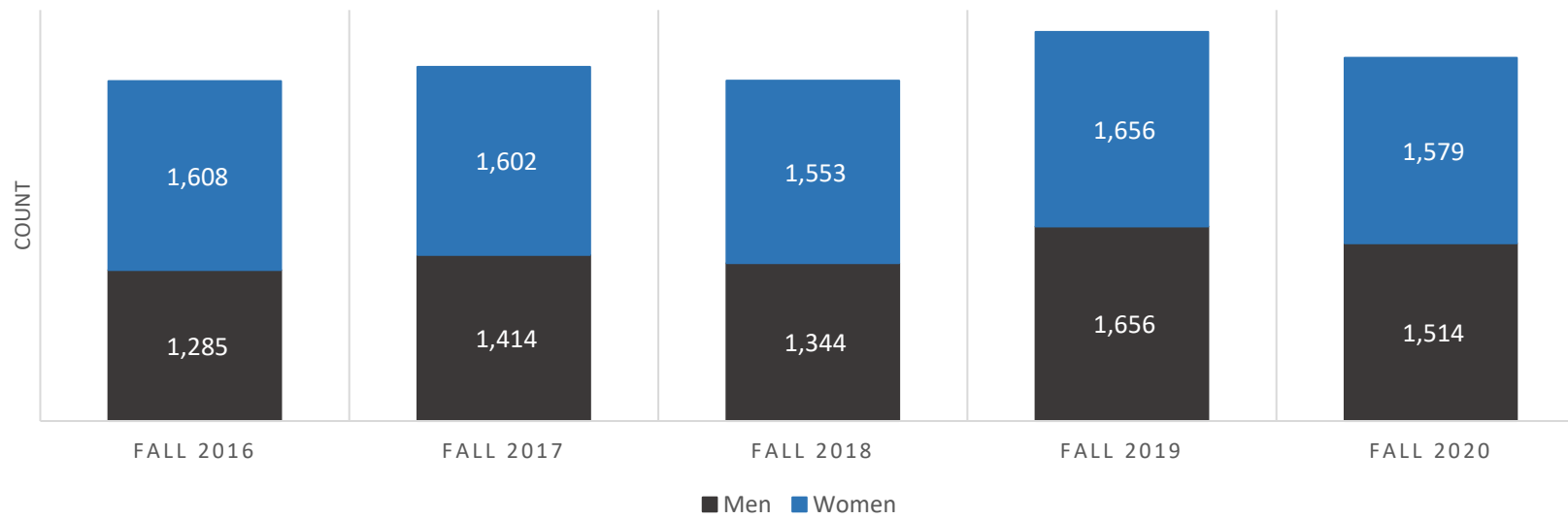

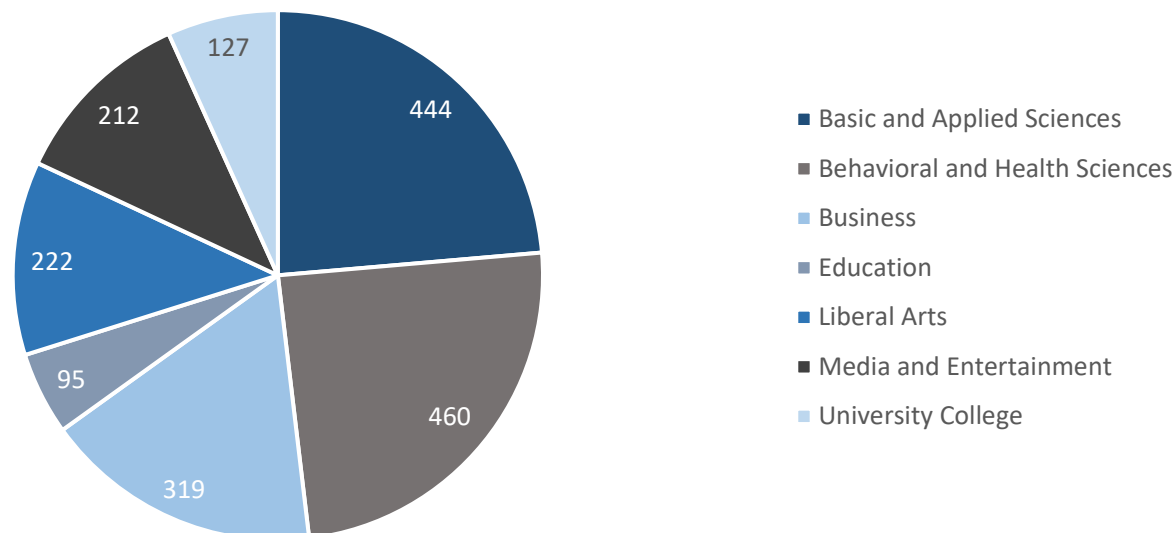

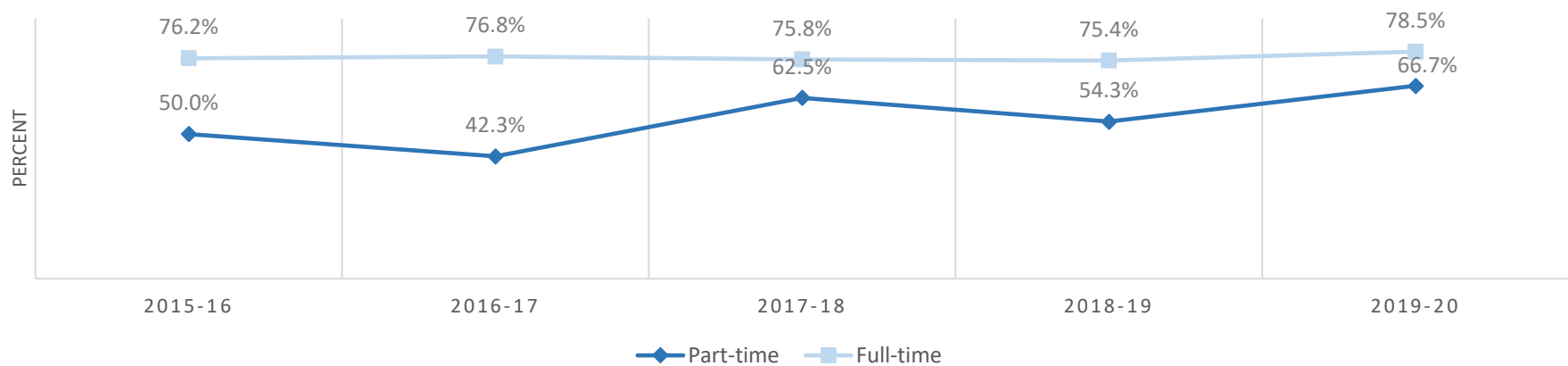

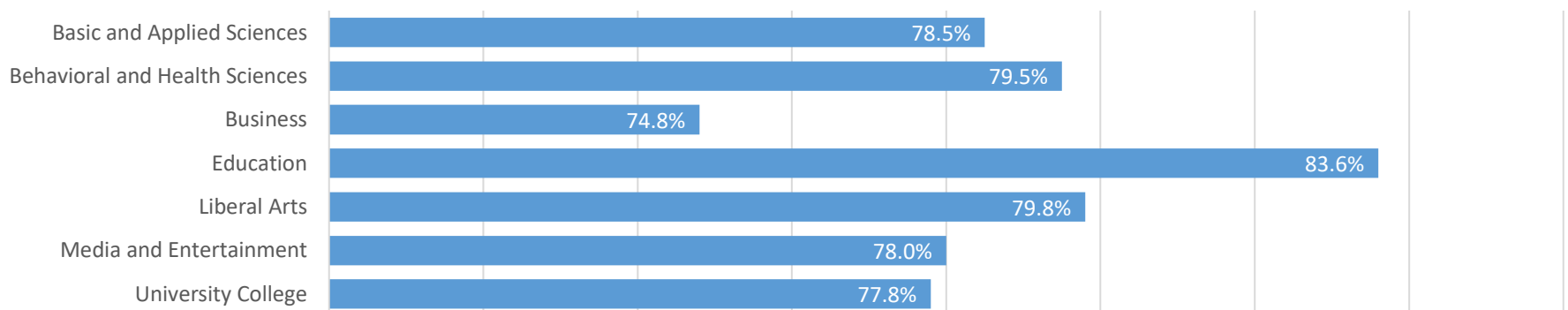

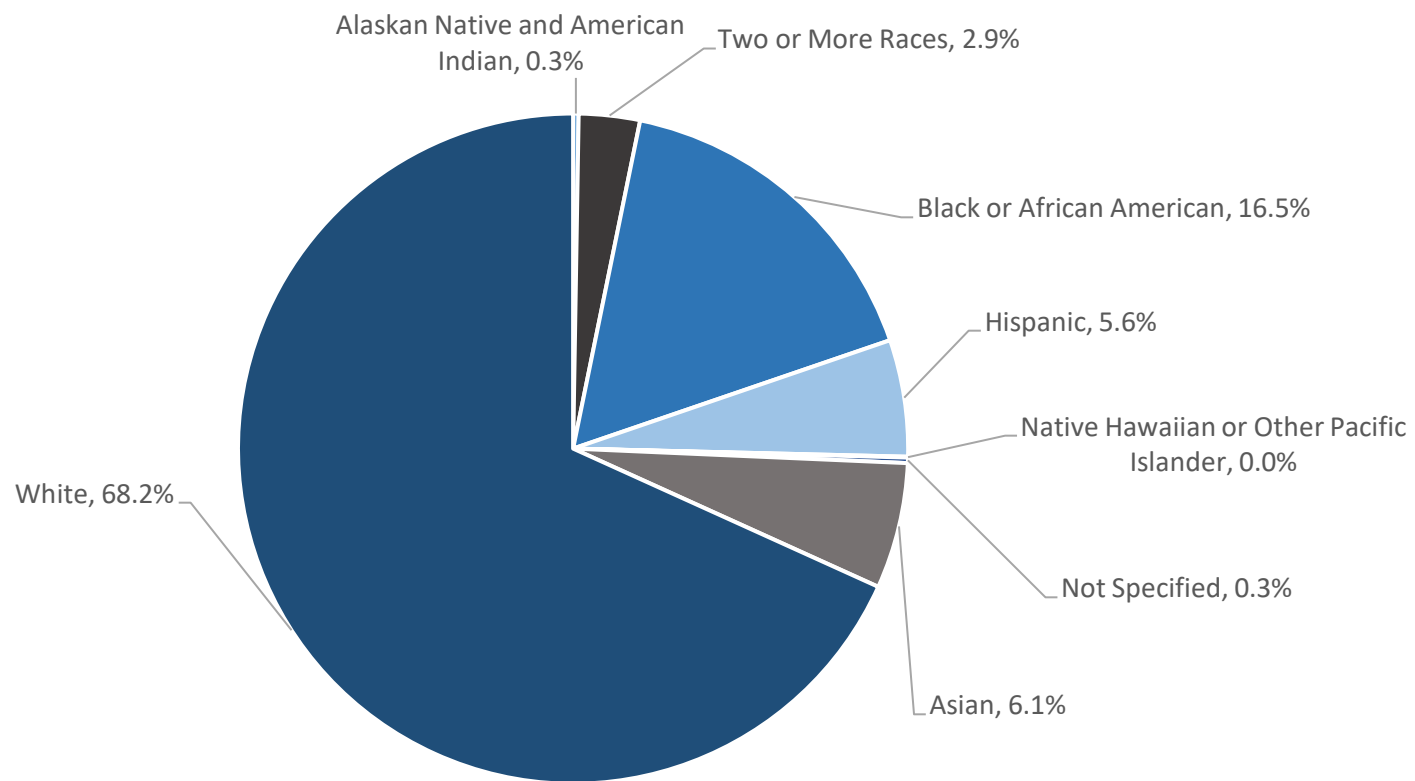

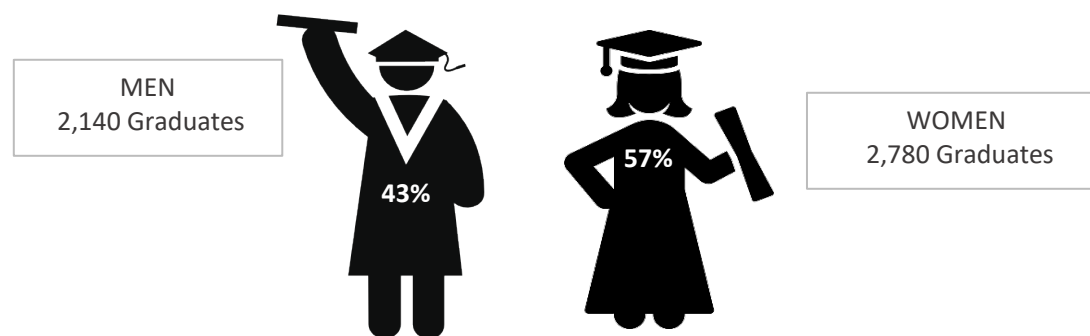

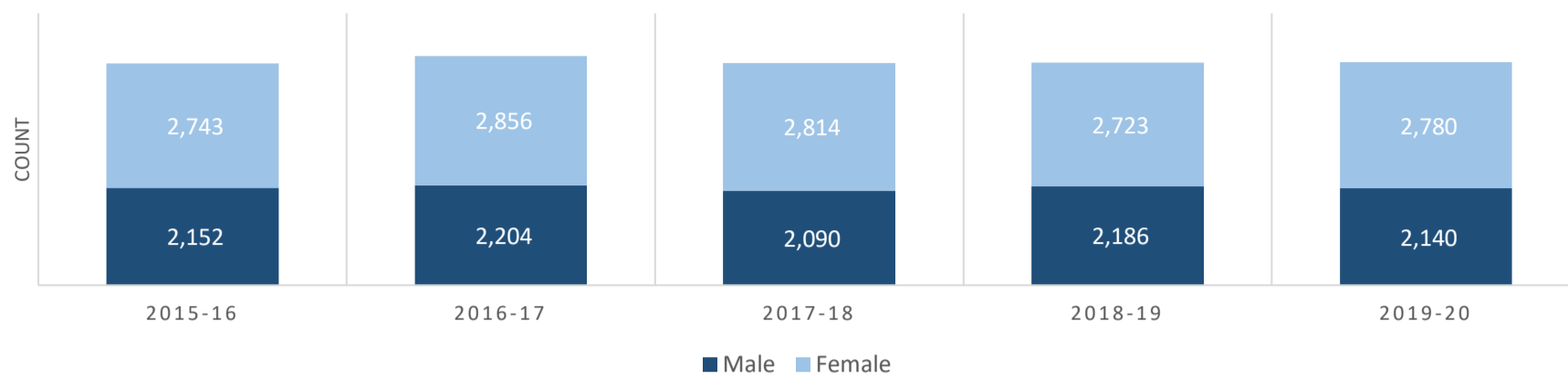

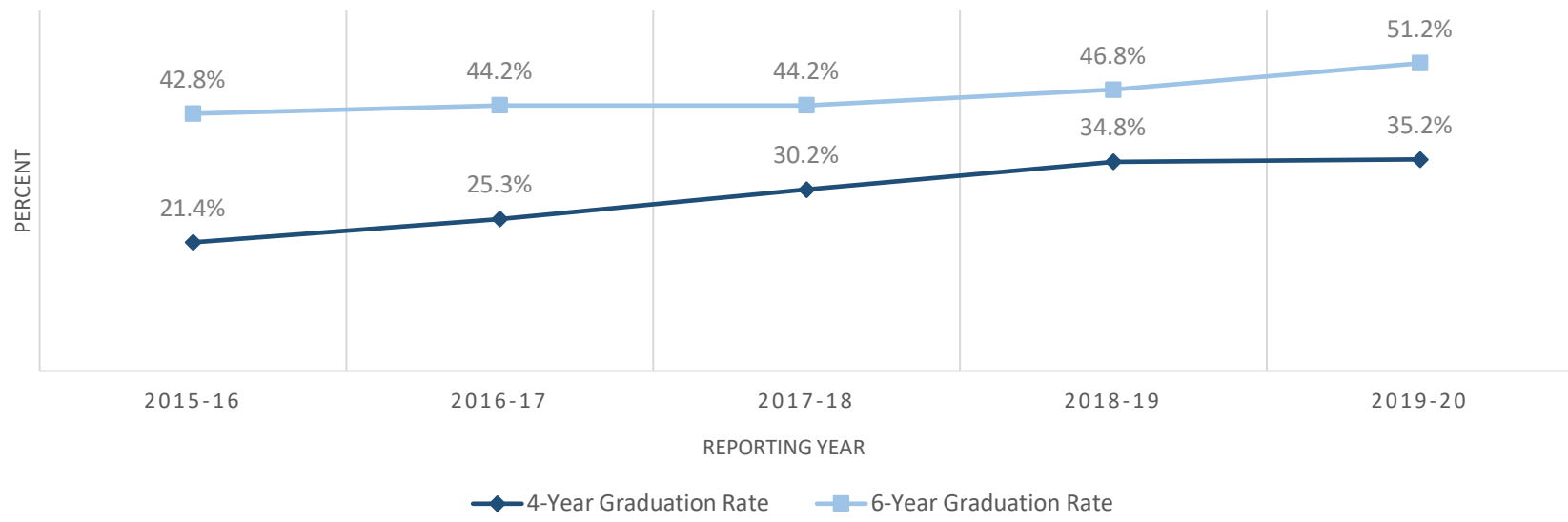

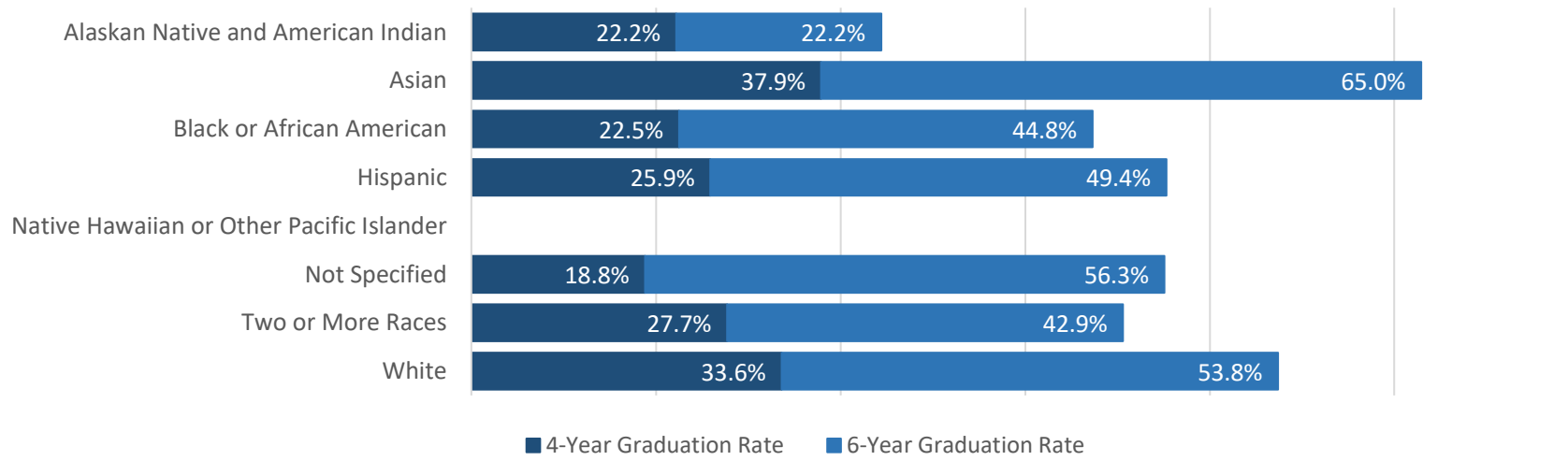

Institutional Graduation Rates by Ethnicity

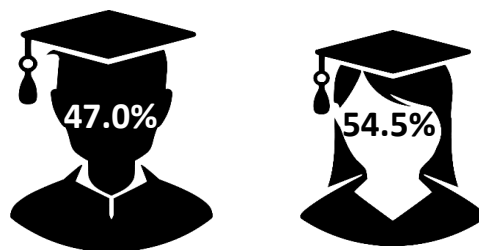

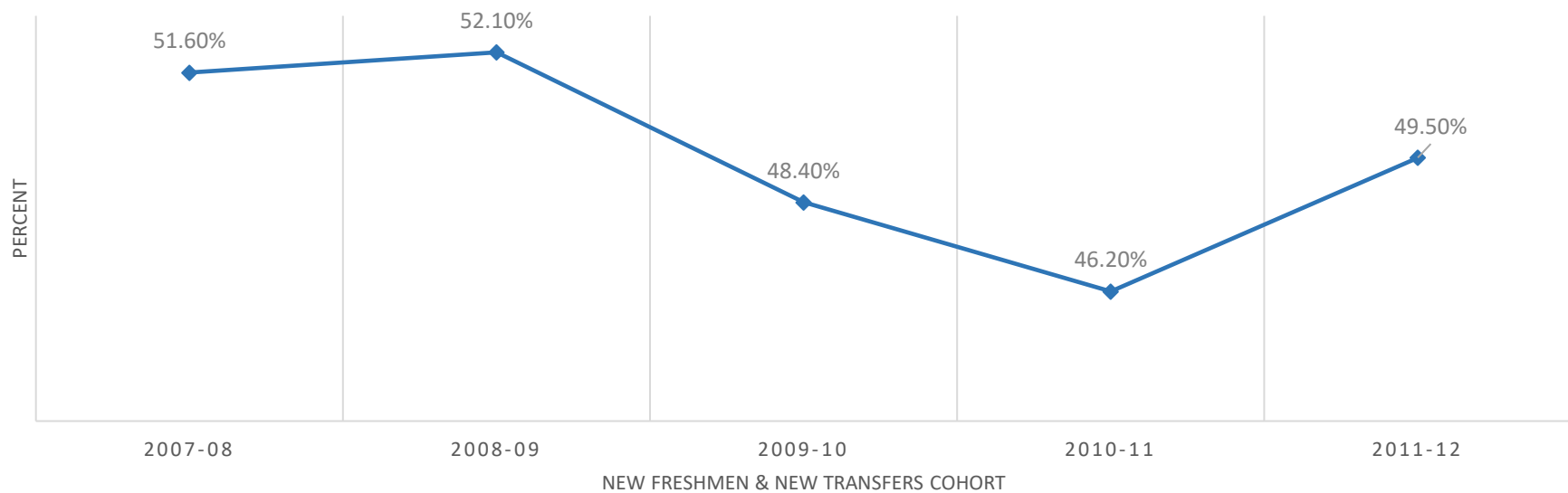
