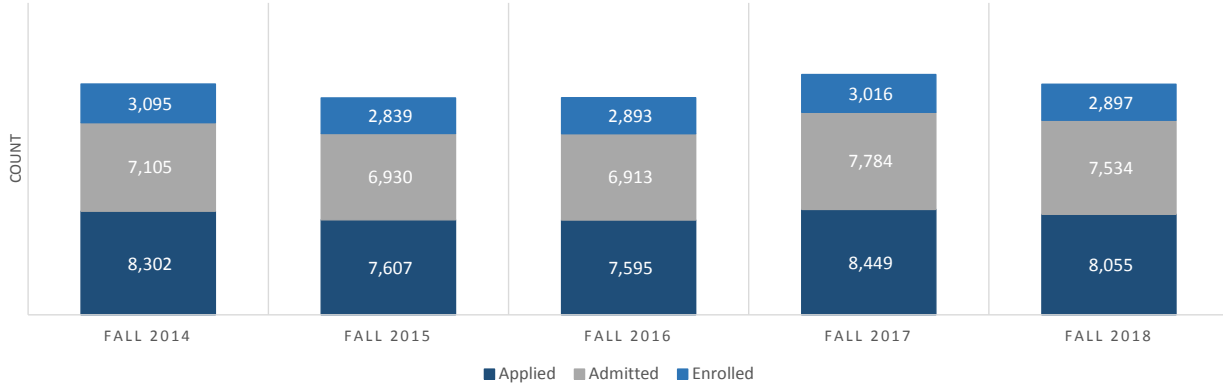

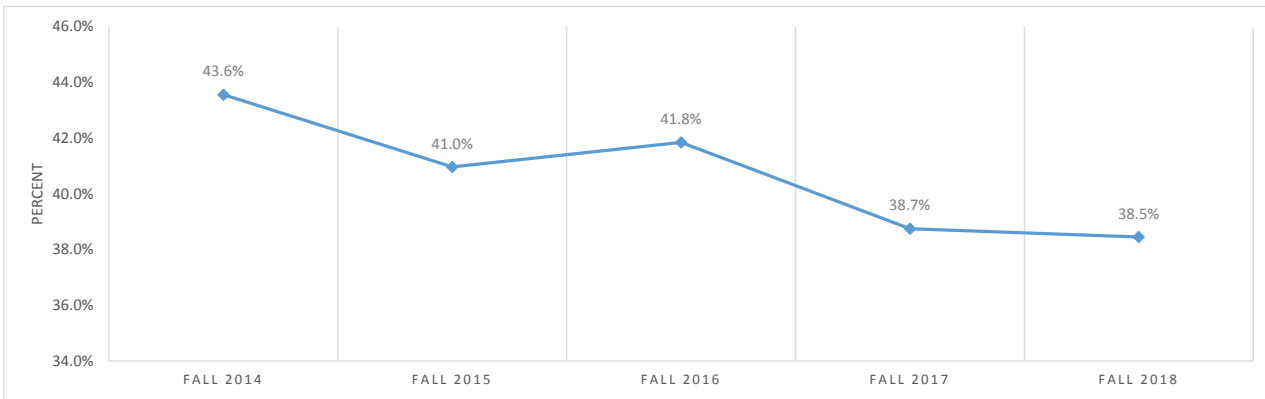

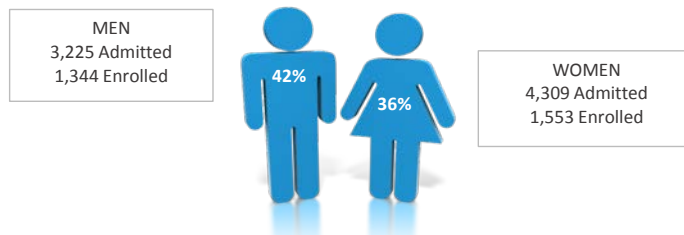
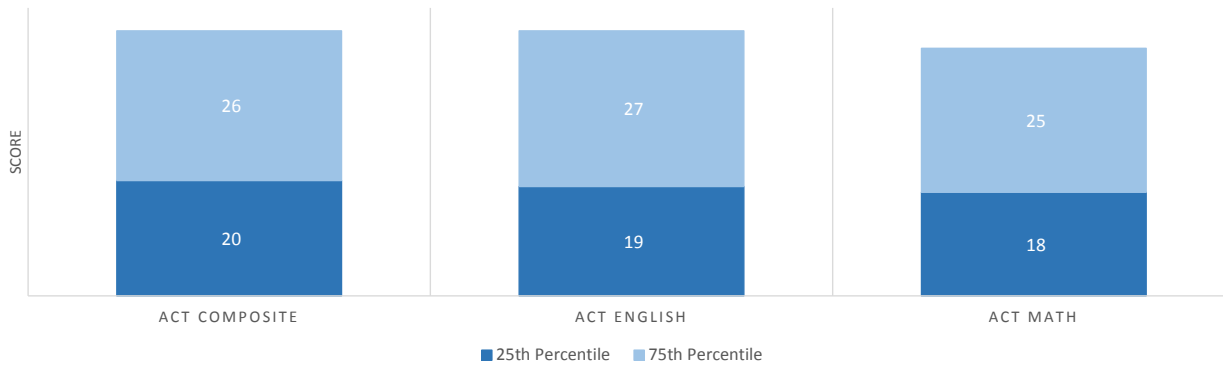
**New Freshmen Applied, Admitted and Enrolled**



**Percent of Admitted New Freshmen Who Enrolled**



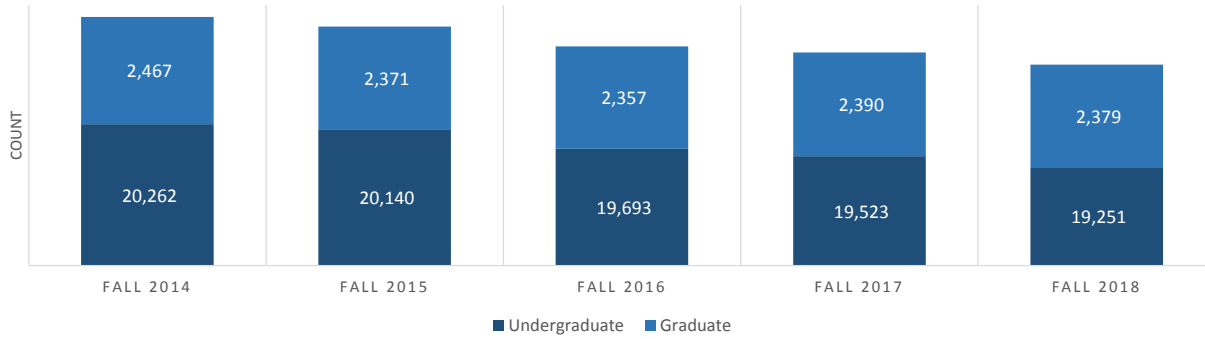
**ACT Scores of New Freshmen Enrolled Fall 2018**



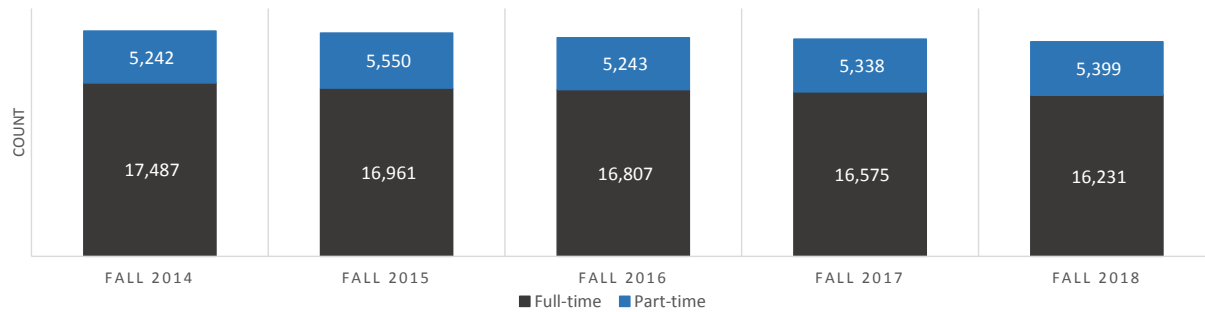

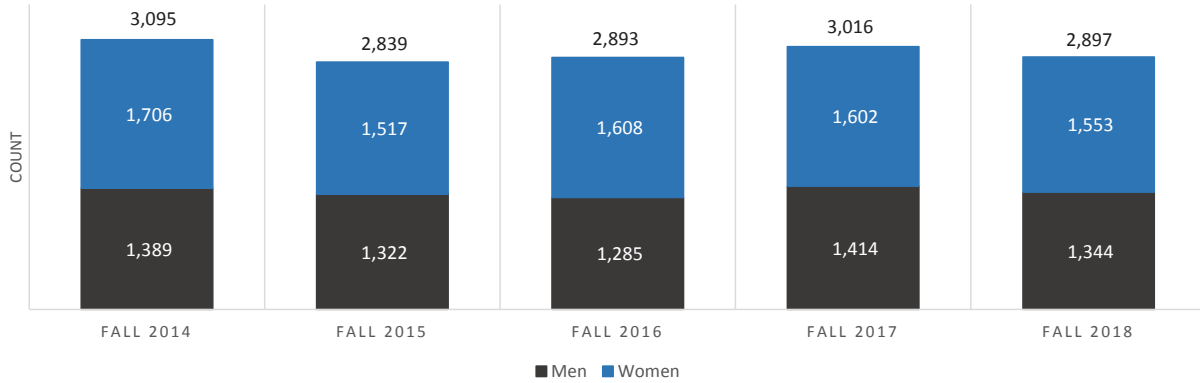

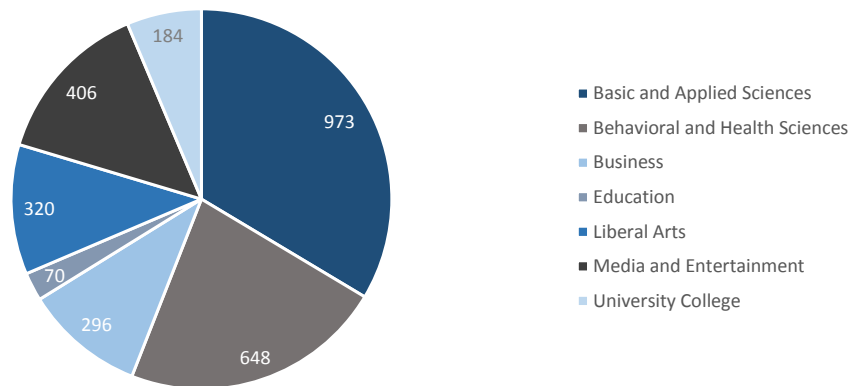

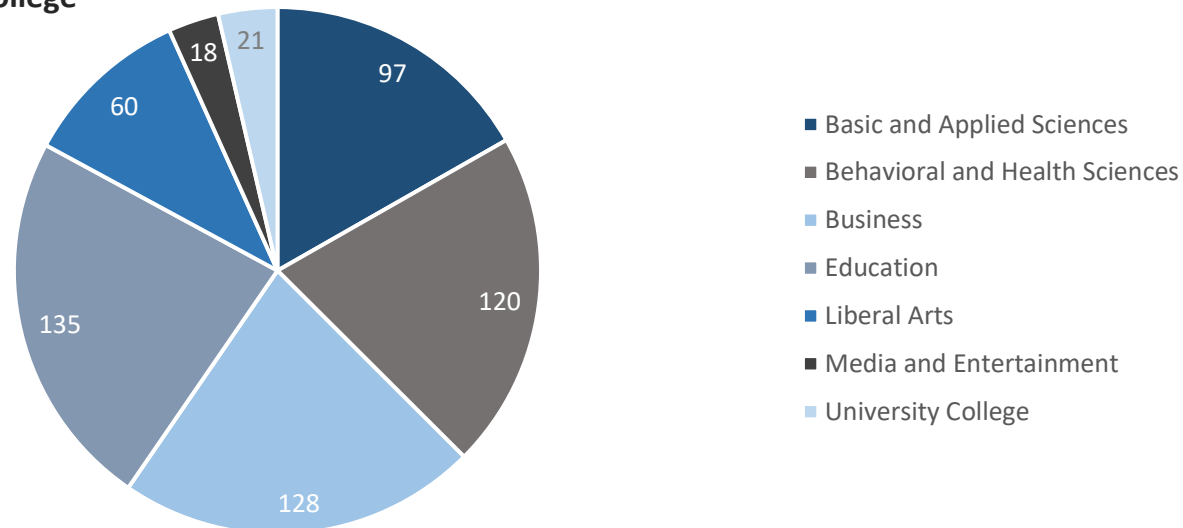

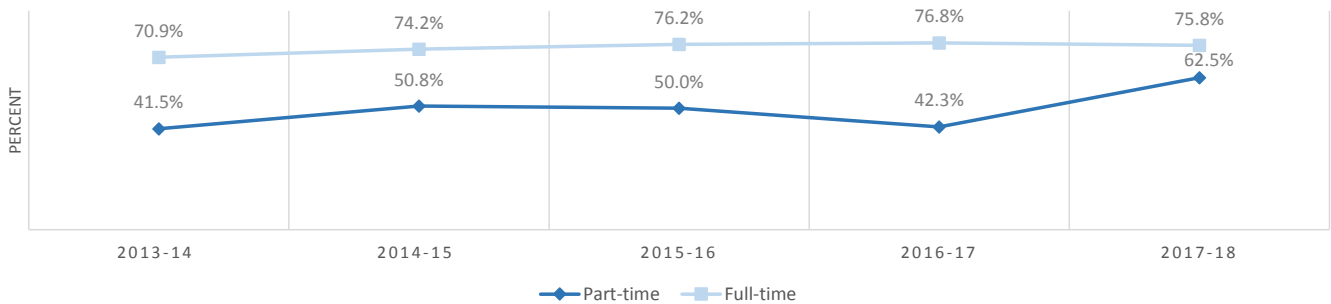

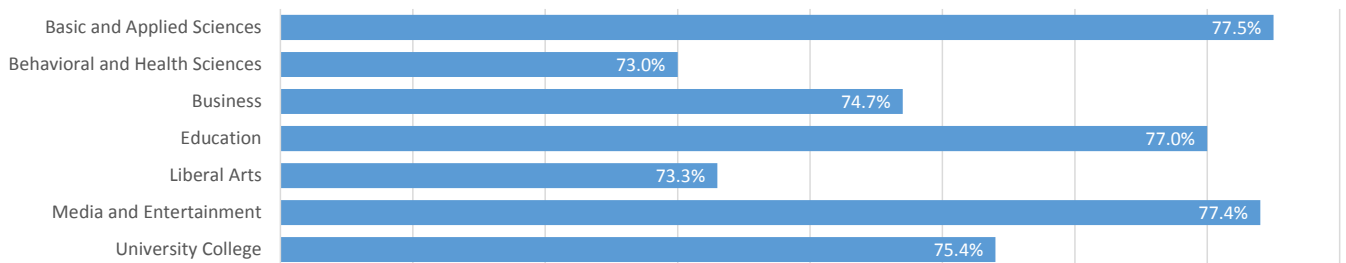

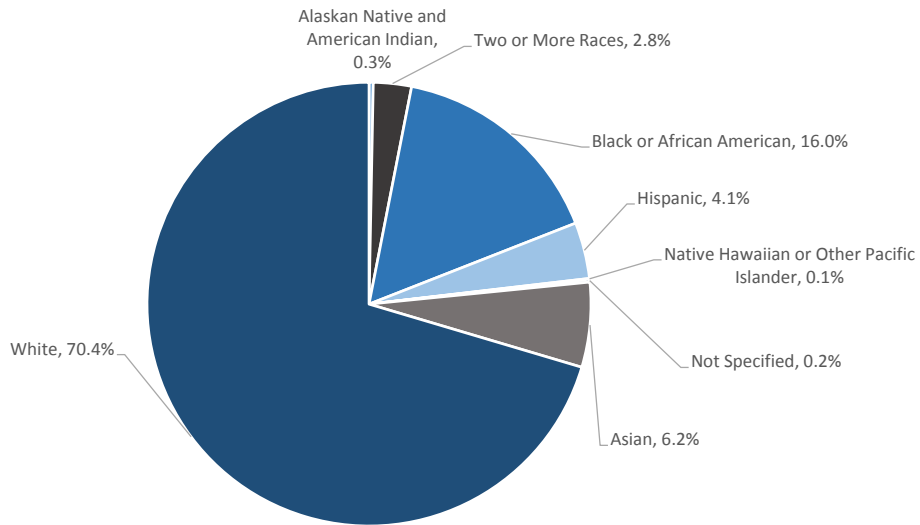

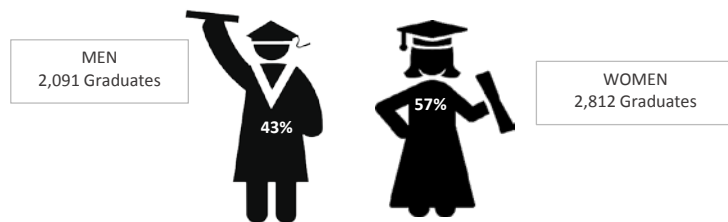

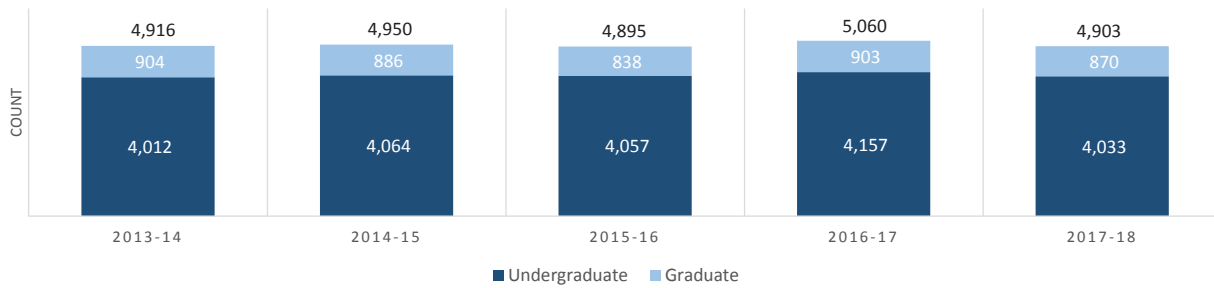

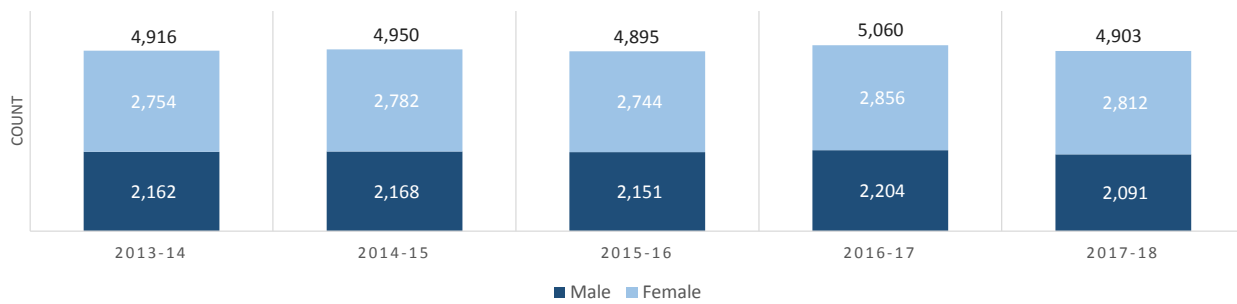

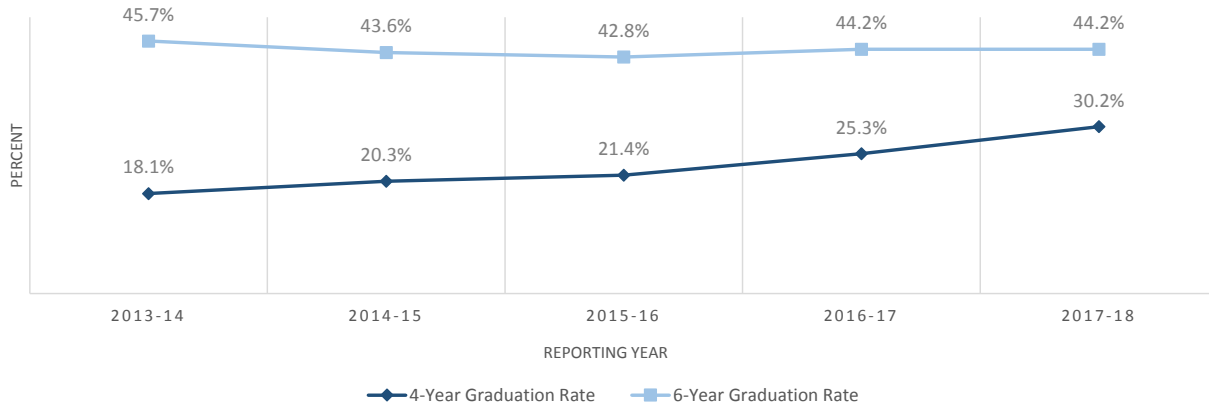

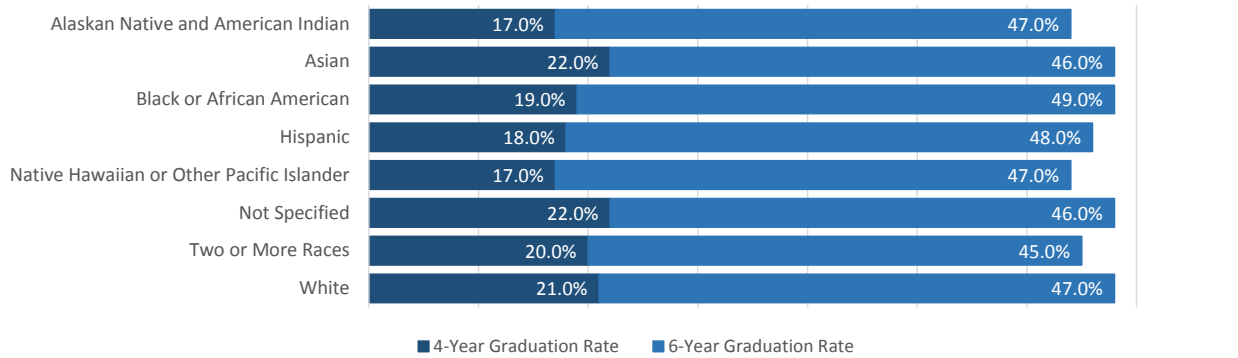
