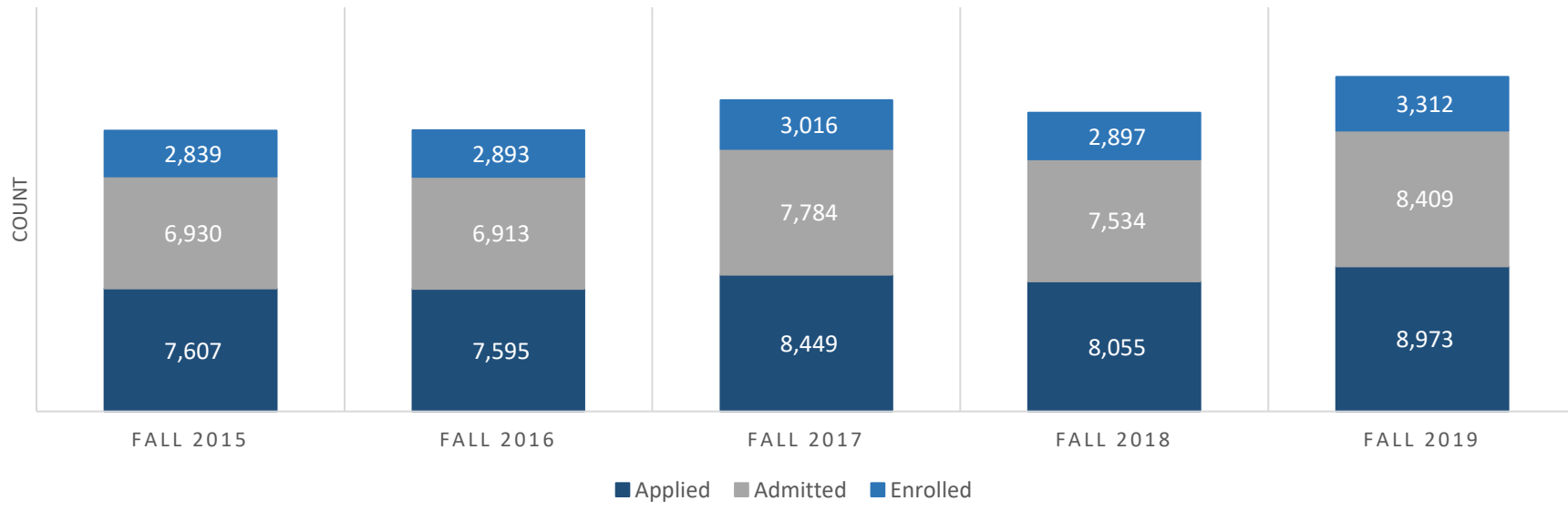

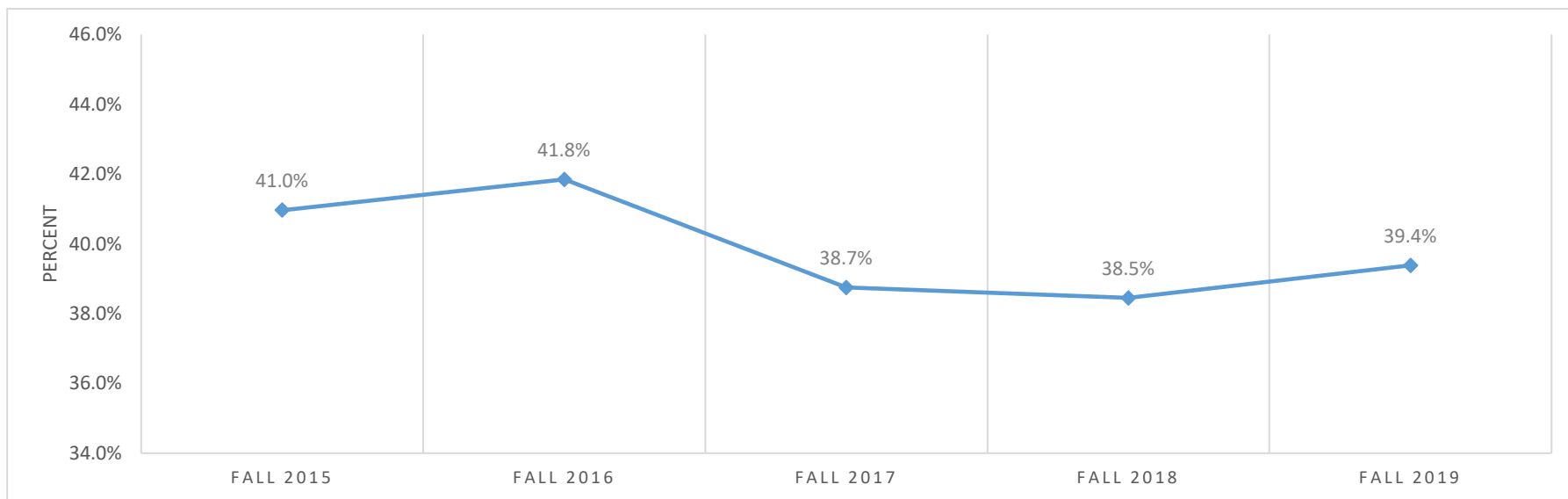

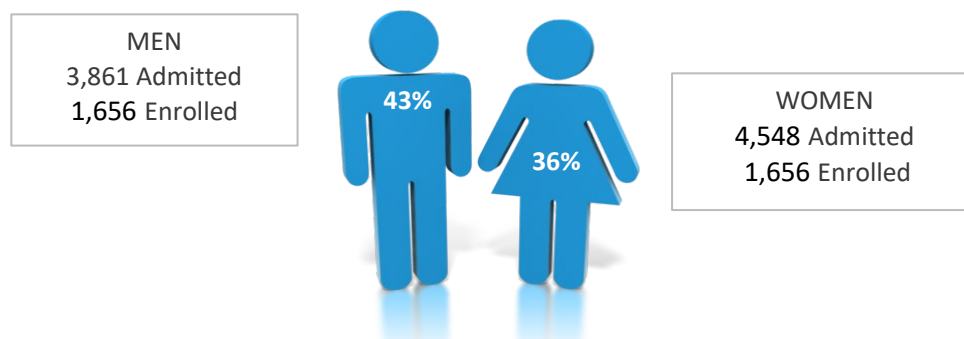
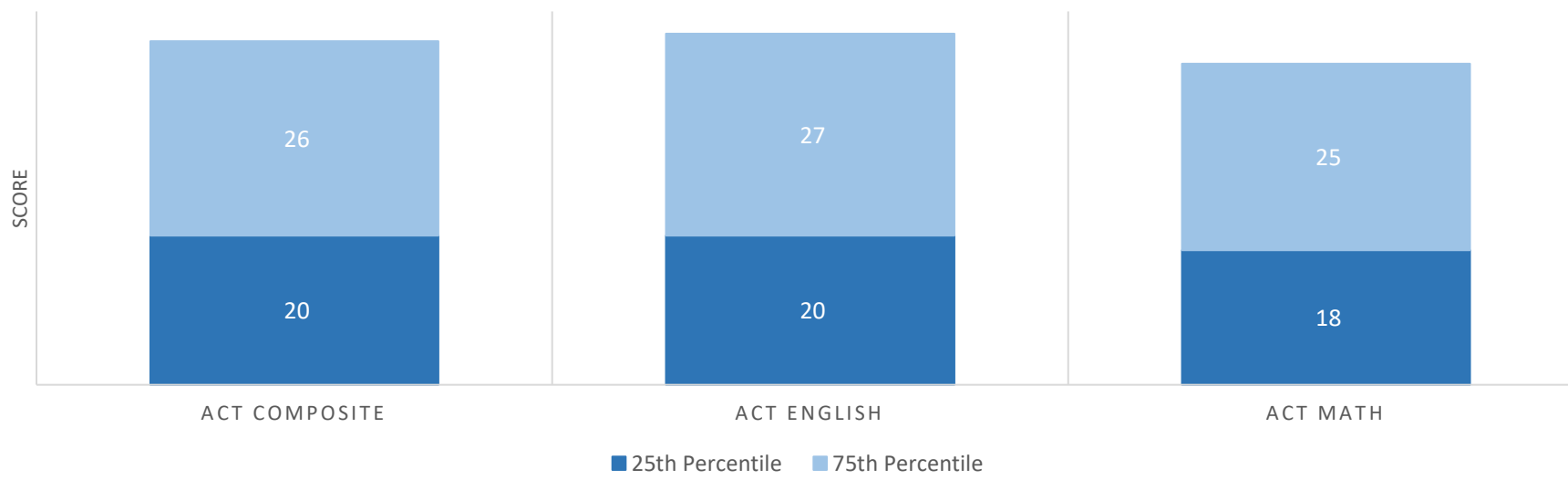
New Freshmen Applied, Admitted and Enrolled

Fall 2019 Admitted and Enrolled by Gender

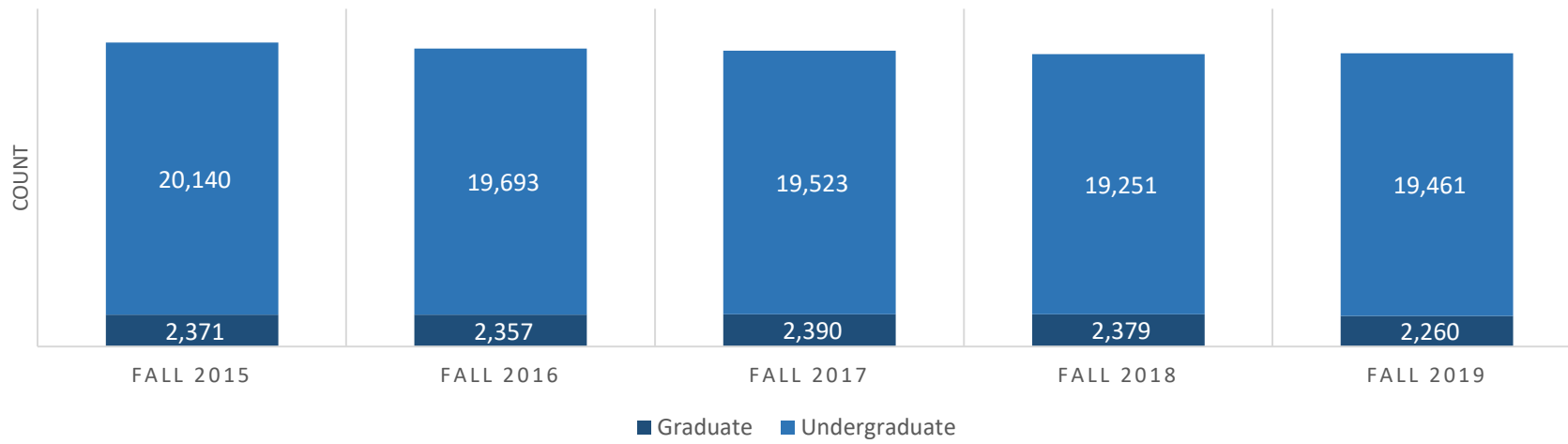

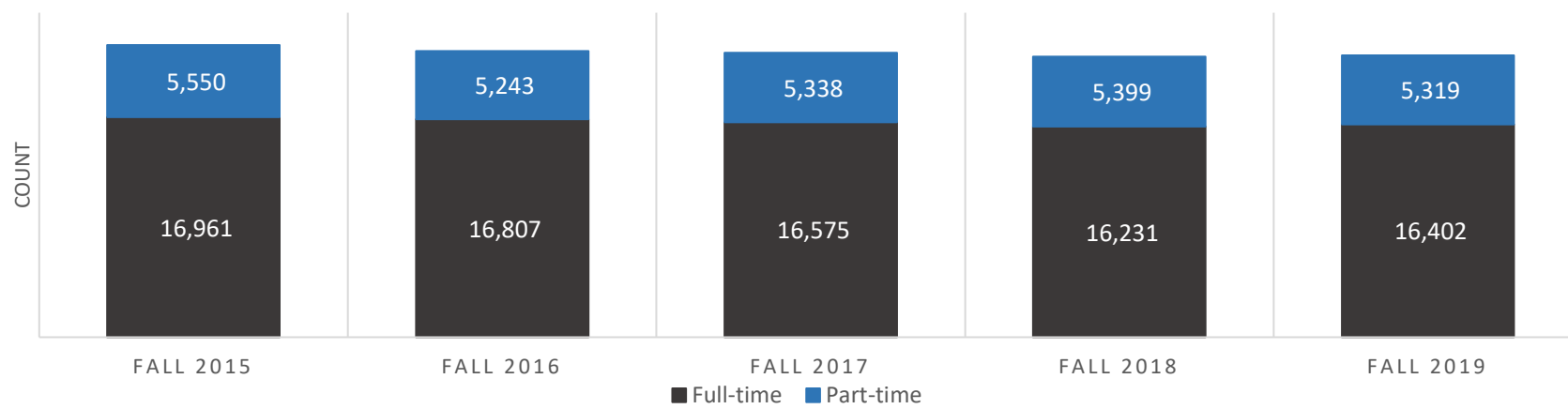

Total Fall Headcount by Enrollment Status



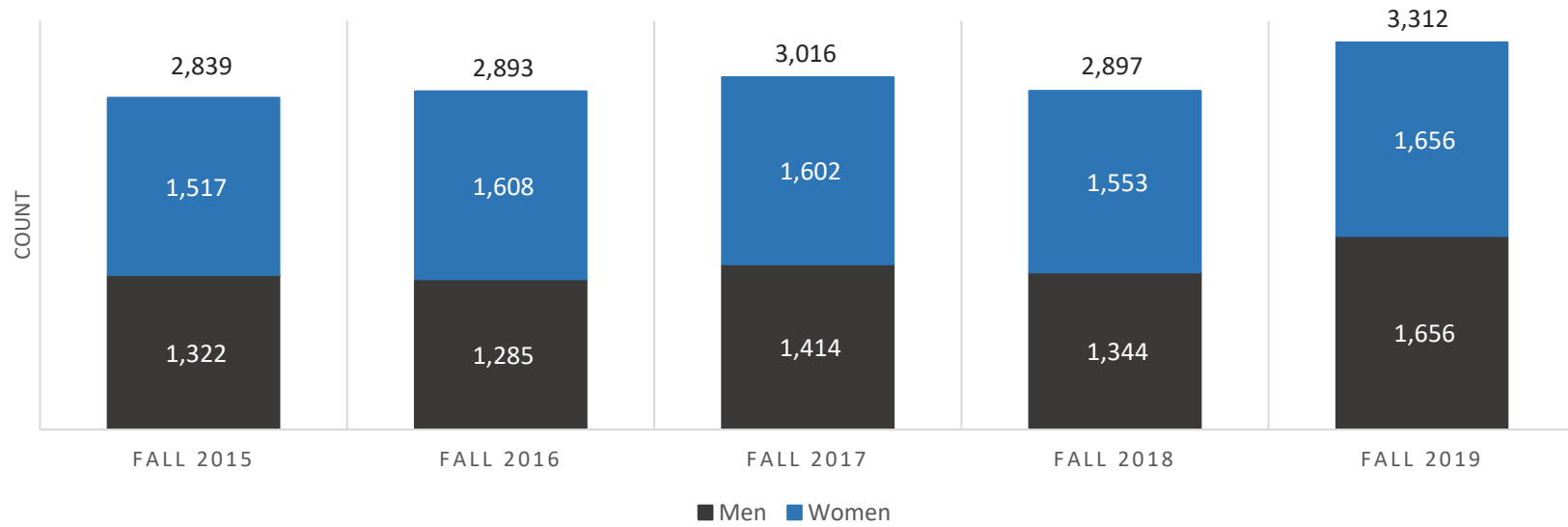

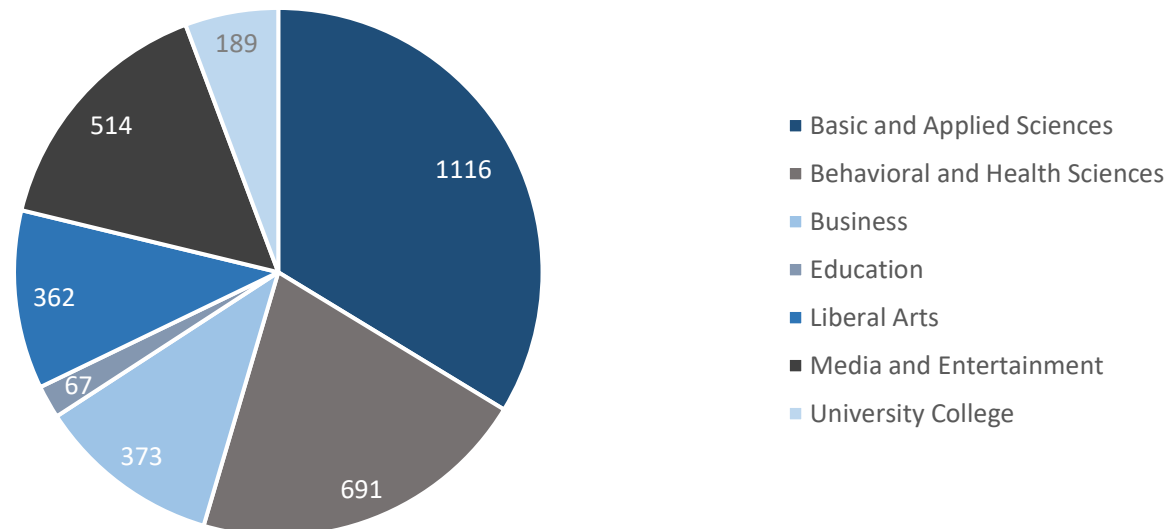

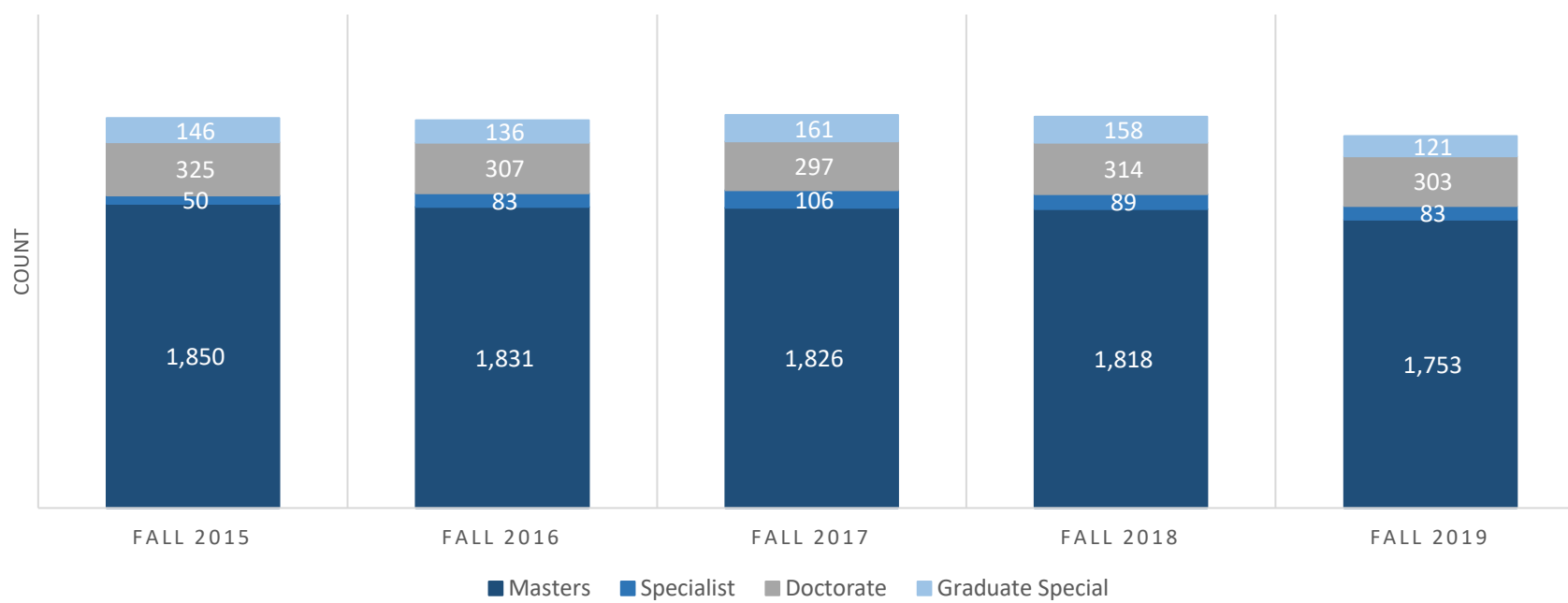

Graduate Headcount by Classification



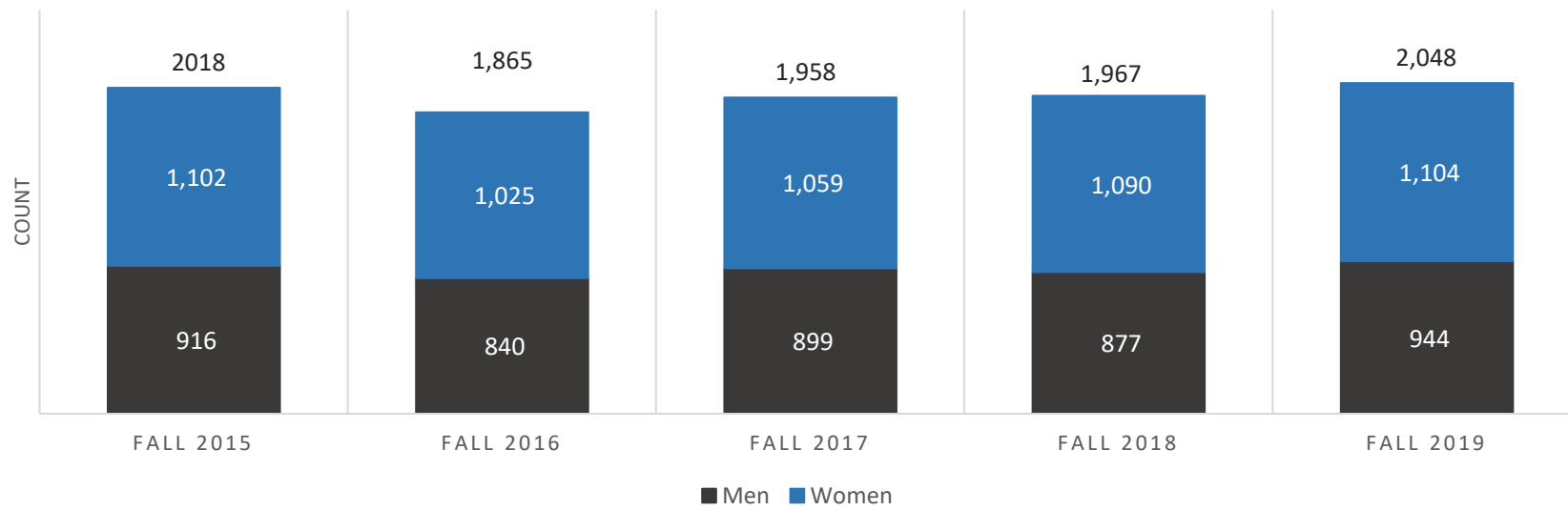

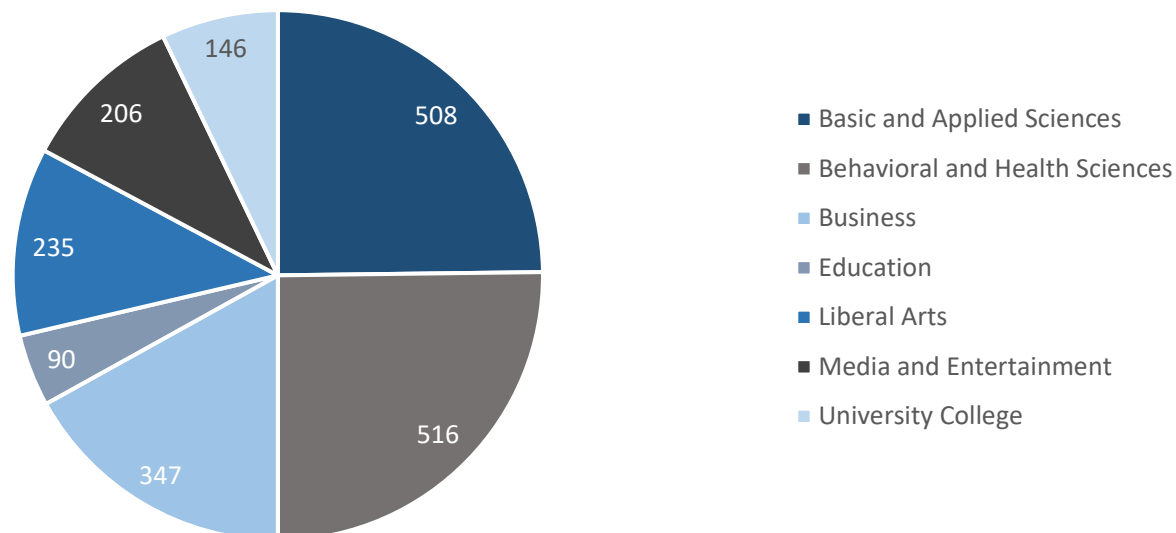

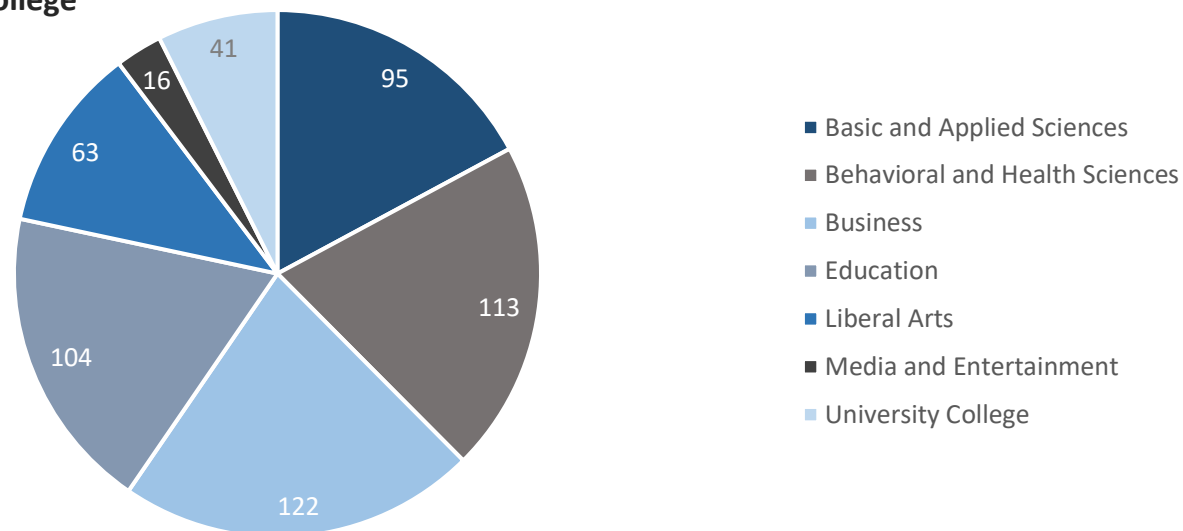

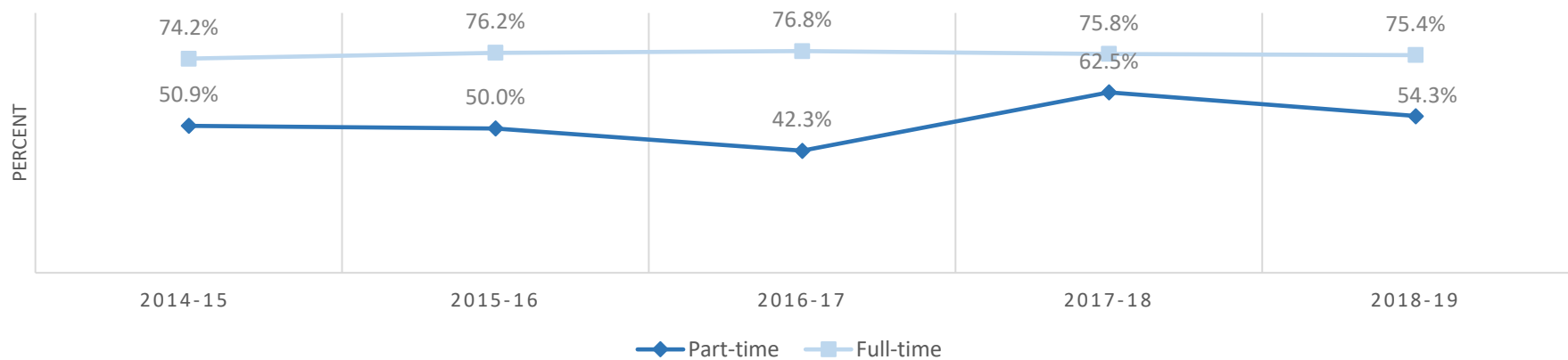

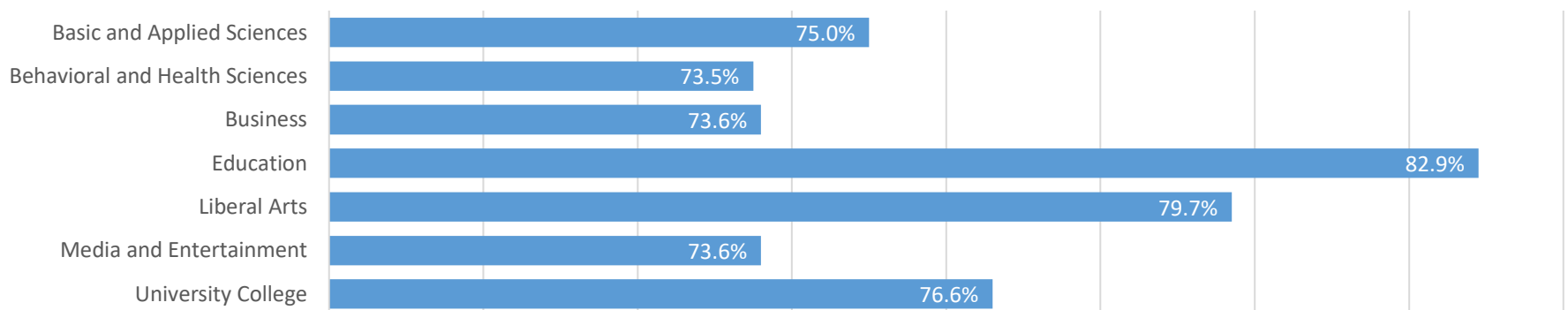

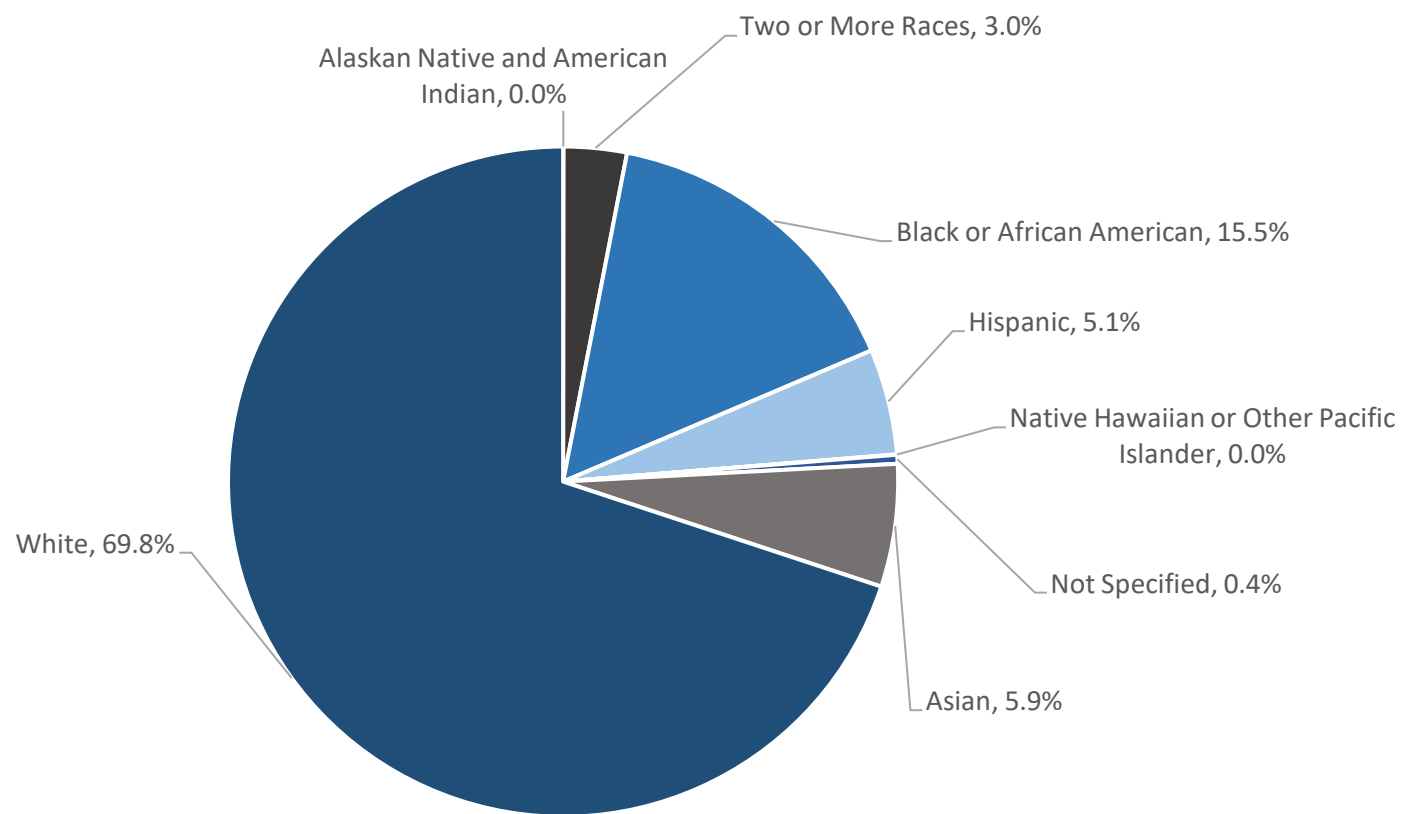

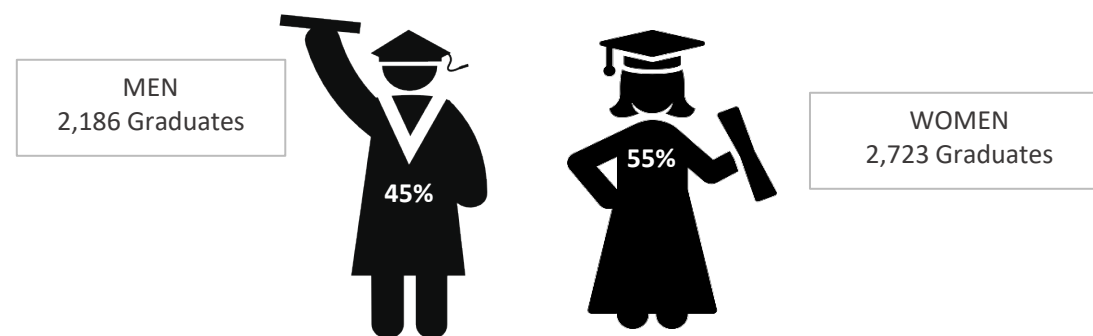

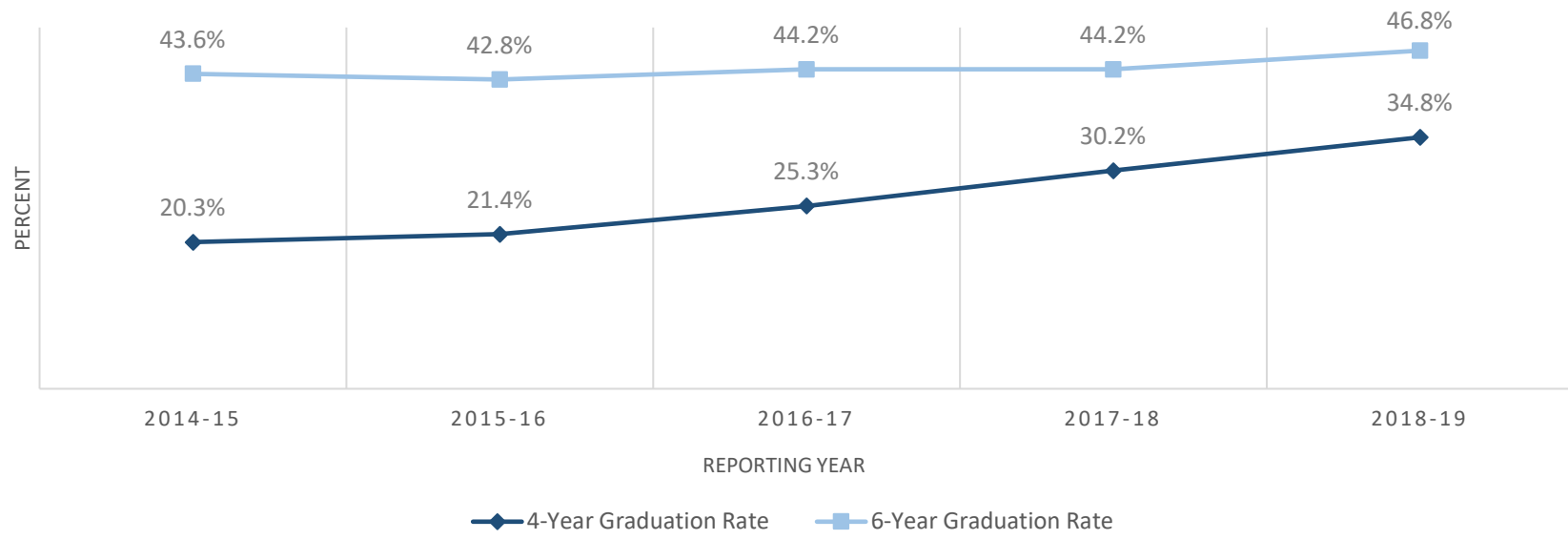

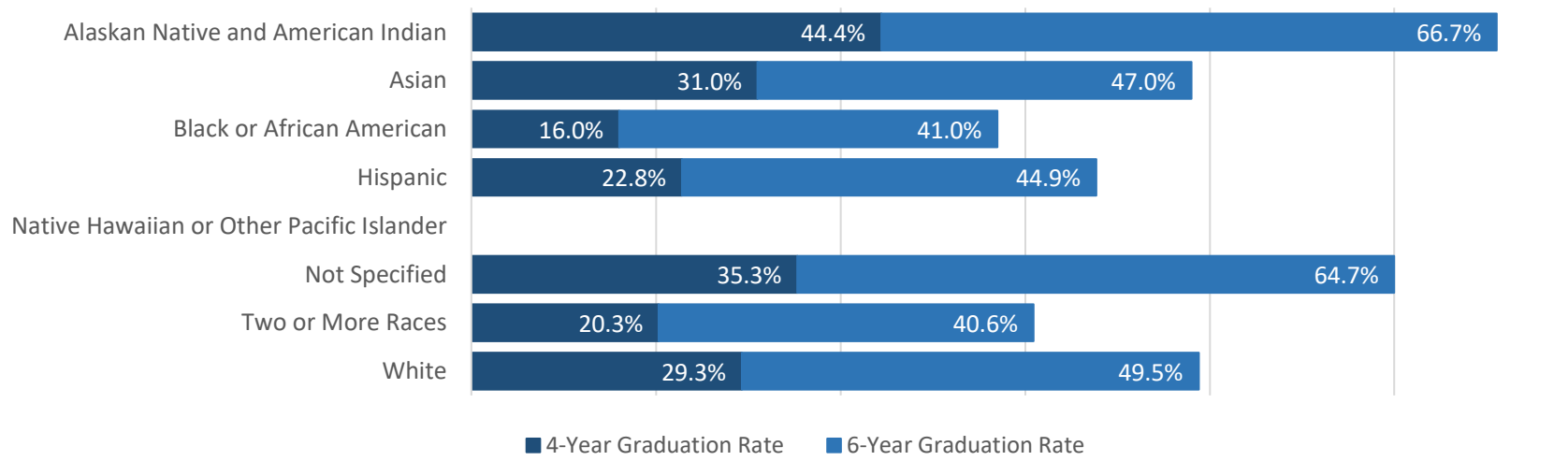

Institutional Graduation Rates by Ethnicity

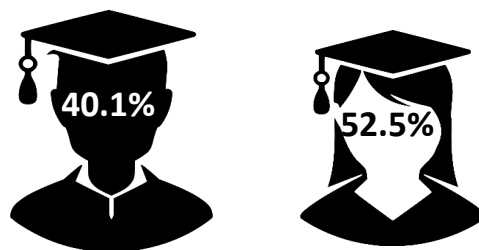

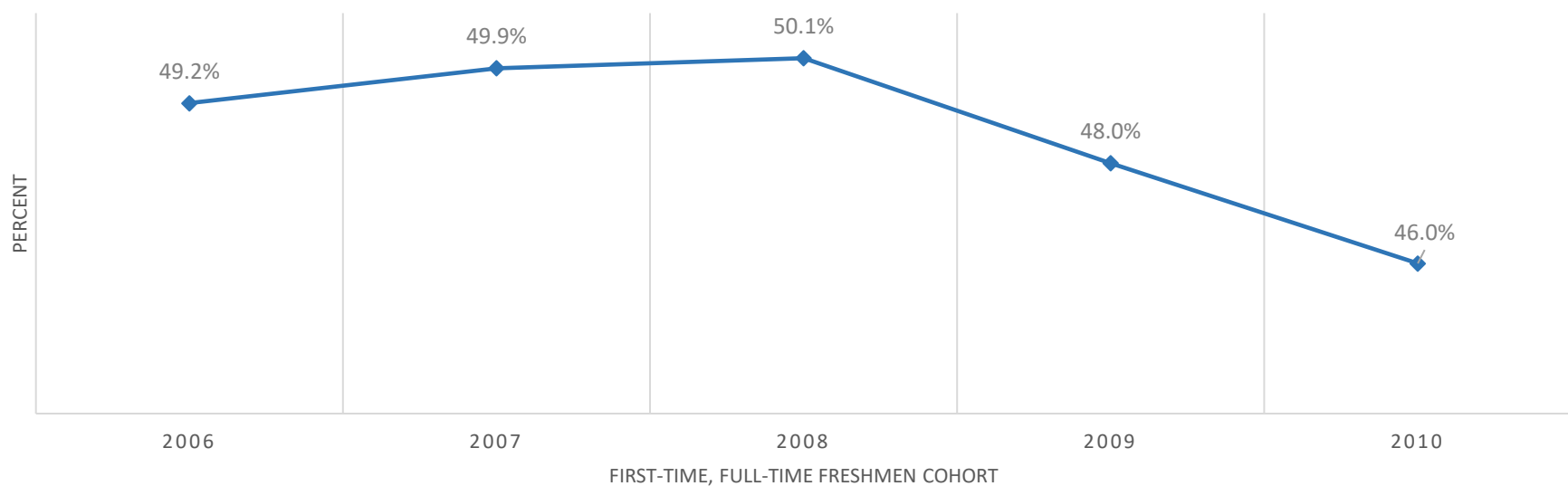
