Graduate Studies Application Procedures

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis for study beginning in Fall, Spring or Summer, but deadlines apply. Consult the College of Graduate Studies "Apply Now" link at the bottom of the previous web page for relevant deadlines. If you wish to be considered for a Graduate Assistantship, however, the following deadlines apply:

Deadlines to be considered for one of our Graduate Assistantships:

March 1 for the Fall Semester

November 1 for the Spring Semester

General Application Procedures:

For all applications to the Graduate School in Music, an applicant must **complete each of the following:**

1. Submit application with the appropriate fee (online at www.mtsu.edu/graduate/apply.php)
2. Submit official transcripts of all previous college work
3. Submit three letters of recommendation.

Procedures for Individual Specializations:

Depending on the specialization of interest, an applicant must also **complete one of the Special Requirements for Admission:**

- Complete an audition or submit an audition recording (Performance)
- Submit scores and recordings of your compositions (Composition)
- Submit 2 written samples of scholarship (Musicology)
- Submit a 30-minute teaching demonstration video (Education)
