BUDGETING PROCESS ACT OF 1998

Whereas, Currently, no where is there defined the proper procedure for approving the SGA budget,

And, This has led to different interpretations and inconsistency,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED BY THE 61ST SGA CONGRESS OF
MTSU THAT:

Section 1. The SGA President shall submit a budget to each house of Congress.

Section 2. If either house amends the budget before passage, there shall be a committee formed consisting of an equal apportionment of members from each house to produce one form of the budget that is in agreement with both houses. Upon agreement by the committee, the amended budget shall return to each house for passage. If the budget is amended again, it will be sent back to committee, and repeat this process until both houses pass the same form of the budget.

Section 3. All budgets must contain an appropriation clause, enacting the use of funds upon congressional passage, the President's signature, and the signature of the Vice-President for Student Affairs.

Section 4. This act will go into effect immediately, the student welfare requiring.
