SGA Bill No. 5-03-F

A bill to impeach Senator Khanthaly Phrommala from representing the college of Basic and Applied Sciences.

Whereas: Khanthaly Phrommala missed two consecutive Senate meetings unexcused

Whereas: The attendance requirements for retaining a Senate seat stipulate that no senator is allowed to miss two consecutive unexcused absences.

Whereas: Because Khanthaly Phrommala failed to meet his obligations as a senator in the MTSU, SGA he should be impeached.

Therefore, let it be resolved by the 66th SGA Congress that:

Section 1. Upon passage from the Senate, the Speaker shall appoint a committee of five for the purpose of investigation and that the five senators consist of:

- 1. Senator Jenny Rowan, Internal Affairs
- 2. Senator Ashley Elizabeth Graham, Internal Affairs
- 3. Senator Jason Hooper, Internal Affairs
- 4. Senator Kyle Tolbert, Internal Affairs
- 5. Senator Jason Searles, External Affairs

Section 2. The result of the committee shall be presented to the Senate.

Section 3. Upon a 2/3 vote in favor of impeachment, Khanthaly Phrommala shall become impeached, with the understanding, in accordance of Article 9, Section 3, Letter C, that he shall never pursue any other office within the SGA for the remainder of his attendance at MTSU.
