A bill to amend Bill Number 12, relative to defining the selection process for Who's Who Among American Colleges and Universities.

Therefore, let it be resolved by the 66th Congress of Student Government Association of Middle Tennessee State University.

Section 1: Under Section 1, Selection, strike out the word eight and add the word five to members of the Faculty Senate and strike out the words Speaker of House and add the words Vice President of Administration and Public Affairs.

Section 2: Under Section 2, strike out the words *the Student Government Association Speaker of the House* and add the words **Director of Leadership Development**.

Section 3: Under Section 3, strike out the word eight and add the word five.

Section 4: Under Section 4, Eligibility, strike out of 2.8 and add of 3.0.

Section 5: Under Section 7, strike out the words read over the campus radio station, and placed on the grill monitors and add the words Pipeline MT and strike out SGA Office and add the words Leadership Development.

Section 6: Under Section 7, in the Honors and Awards category, remove the words Class Beauty and Bachelor of Ugliness.

Section 7: Under Section 8, A. strike out the words three consecutive days and add the words **two weeks**. C. Remove the words **and GPA** and remove the words In the case of a student who does not have a 2.8 average, only the applicants name will be covered. D. Strike out the words at least thirty percent of the application forms and add the word **applicants**. E. Strike out the word twelve and add the word **eight** and strike out the words Dean of Students, Associate Dean of Students, and an SGA appointed official, who has not already served on the committee and there can be no discussion of the application forms during this vote and add the words **selection committee**.

Section 8: Under Section 10, strike out the words no later than three school days after and add the word once and strike out the words associate Dean of Students and add the words Director of Leadership Development.
