

SGA Resolution 09-07-F

A resolution petitioning MTSU Campus Planning to perform an analysis on all sidewalks on the campus to determine which sections of sidewalk are in need of settlement repairs.

Whereas: Various sections of campus, such as sidewalks running parallel to Jim Cummings Hall and Corlew, have developed apparent settlement problems;

Whereas: The surface of sidewalks in these and other sections, have settled to a point that is at a lower grade than the curbed edge;


Whereas: It is unfortunate that due to the aforementioned problem, students are forced to walk in the road, in the mud, and other areas on days of rain, due to the depth of water which ponds in these areas;

Whereas: Areas of sidewalk which has suffered settlement, poses the threat of tripping, due to the difference in height of surface grade and the elevated curbing on the edge of the sidewalk.


THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 70TH CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION AT MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY:
