A Resolution to Install Bike Pumps on Campus

Whereas: A great number of students, faculty, and staff who live both on and off campus use

bicycles as either their primary or secondary form of transportation

Whereas: Bike tires gradually lose air pressure as part of everyday wear and tear from riding, and

flat tires are a frequent occurrence.

Whereas: If students/faculty/staff do not live on campus, re-inflating said flat tire becomes more

than a small inconvenience and can make one late for classes, work, and emergency

situations

Whereas: The instillation of community bike pumps would provide a very valuable service to

students riding bikes at a very minimal cost to the university

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 73rd CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: There shall be two bicycle pumps installed on campus. One shall be located by the bike racks in front of Todd Hall, and the other shall be located by the bike racks in front of the

BAS.

Section 2: The pumps shall be bolted to the ground to prevent theft.

Section 3: The pumps will be available for use by all students, faculty, staff, and community members who use bicycles on campus.

Section 4: \$50 a year will be set aside for the maintenance of the pumps or purchase of new pumps if needed.
