

SGA Bill 1-16-S

A Bill To Require Each SGA Senator to Participate in the SGA PUSH Initiative

Whereas: SGA is the voice of the MTSU student body.

Whereas: Many students are unaware of the impact SGA has at MTSU.

Whereas: The SGA PUSH initiative will allow SGA senators to connect with the students whom they represent.

Whereas: The SGA PUSH initiative will enhance each Senator’s leadership skills.

Whereas: SGA PUSH initiative will allow students to more easily connect with their SGA representatives.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 78th CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: Each Senator shall be required to present the Student Government Association via the PUSH initiative to at least one student organization or classroom per semester.

Section 2: To confirm that the Senator did in fact present, he/she will complete a SGA PUSH form and return it to the Executive Vice President, who will confirm this with the leader of the organization or the teacher of the class.

Section 3: The Senator will receive one hour for each class or organization in which they present, up to three hours per semester. The student can be a member of the organization or class in which they present. No two Senators shall be allowed to present SGA PUSH initiative to the same class or organization per semester.

Section 4: This bill shall go into effect for the 79th Congress of the Student Government Association upon favorable passage, and shall be binding on all future Congresses.
