THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 76th CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1:	The Student Activity Fee paid by students taking seven or more credit hours will be
	increased from \$20.00 to \$40.00 per person.

- **Section 2:** The Student Activity Fee will be increased by \$5.00 per year per student until the full amount is met.
- Section 3: A new fund called "Signature Events" will be added to the allocation.
- **Section 4:** The Signature Events fund will be managed by SGA.
- **Section 5:** The Student Activity Fee at full amount paid will be allocated as follows:

٠	Student Government Association	15%	\$6.00
•	Student Programming	15%	\$6.00
•	Sport Clubs	10%	\$4.00
•	Distinguished Lectures	10%	\$4.00
•	Signature Events	10%	\$4.00
•	Student Organizations	40%	\$16.00

Section 6: If passed, this increase shall take effect the following year after which it is passed by a majority vote on the referendum of the student body and is approved by the Tennessee Board of Regents.
