**Whereas:** MTSU opened and resumed classes at 11:30am on Monday January 25, 2016

**Whereas:** In the importance of student safety, MTSU closed student parking garages.

**Whereas:** There are a limited number of Red and Green Parking spaces

**Whereas:** Parking Tickets have transformed from enforcing rules to endangering student safety.

**Whereas:** The State of Emergency in The State of Tennessee ended on the 29<sup>th</sup> of January 2016 at 3:00pm.

**THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 78<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:**

**Section 1:** Parking Regulations section 3-2, subsection (b) and (d) are suspended during a State of Emergency in the state of Tennessee if the MTSU parking garages are deemed hazardous to student safety.

**Section 2:** Until hazards within the parking garages are properly disposed, Students holding a Green Permit are allowed to park in Red spaces to ensure student safety.

**Section 3:** This resolution will go into effect immediately upon favorable passage.
