A Resolution to Increase Academic Advisor Productivity

Whereas: Middle Tennessee State University does not give students opportunities to rate

advisors in each individual college.

Whereas: Middle Tennessee State University overall college department chairs do not

have an evaluation of the effectiveness that advisors have on currently enrolled

students.

Whereas: Students should be given the option to evaluate academic advisors to assess

their effectiveness in supporting student's paths to graduation.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 81st CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: Middle Tennessee State University advisors be assessed by an evaluation that is

created by the departments, completed and submitted by currently enrolled students

who are assessing their specific advisor, and reviewed by the respective committee

of the department's choice.

Section 2: The overall evaluation should include the advisor's effectiveness in supporting

student's paths to graduation, regular and effective interaction between the student

and advisor, and overall satisfaction with their advisor's performance.
