Assistant Vice President for University Police and Chief of Police

The position will be responsible for directing and coordinating campus safety and security functions as the chief law enforcement officer under the direction of the Vice President for Business & Finance. Duties include overseeing the enforcement of state and local laws; enforcement of University rules and regulations; prevention, suppression, detection and investigation of crime; managing and/or responding to emergency calls; maintaining and promoting programs to educate the University community on crime prevention; protecting life and property; overseeing the administration of the University's Emergency Operations Plan.

Bachelor's degree required. Eight years progressively responsible law enforcement experience required with a minimum of three years of management experience. P.O.S.T. Certified in the State of Tennessee or eligible for P.O.S.T. Certification in the State of Tennessee within one year of hire is required.

Master's degree preferred. Experience in higher education law enforcement is highly desired.
