Provenance and Acquisition Information:

Jackie Cambell, the daughter of Joyce Suggs Beavers, donated the collection in October 2022. An additional rare book was donated to the center in March 2023. The collection was shipped directly to the Center of Popular Music.

Arrangement:

There was no obvious arrangement for the collection. Some items, including sound recordings and rare books, were organized and separated for ease of access.

Agency History/Biographical Sketch:

Joyce Suggs Beavers was a singer specializing in shape notes. She attended the Stamps Quartet singing school in Dallas, TX from the late 1940s-mid 1950s, and sang with the Stampettes and with the Stamps Harmonettes. Through her work at the Stamps school, she collected souvenirs, song books, photographs, and a few recordings. Later, her daughter also attended the Stamps Quartet singing school in the 1960s, where she was able to meet artists like J.D. Sumner and the Blackwood Brothers. The Stamps school was an important fixture in Joyce's life, and she remained in contact with her group for many years.

Scope and Content:

Joyce Suggs Beavers collected these items during her time at the Stamps Quartet singing school in the late 1940s and during her daughters' time there in the 1960s. The collection includes manuscript materials, LPs, Rare books, 78rpm recordings, artifacts, and photographs – most related to her time with the Stampettes or Shape note music in general. A few items have notes written on them to mark corrections in the music, and one item includes an autograph from J.D. Sumner.
